We Are Called...

We celebrate the gift of the Apostles Peter and Paul. This celebration is about the two foundational members of God's Church that Jesus sends to bring two separate groups of people into God's kingdom by preaching that Jesus Christ is our Lord and Savior. They go into their respective communities to spread the Good News that God is with us. It is the news that we have been given the gift of salvation through the Cross and the Eucharist. It is the preaching of the reality of Jesus, God who became man to be like us in everything except sin, who became sin for us that we might live in the righteousness of God. They are splendid examples of what God is calling us to be through our baptism as priest, prophet, and king. God called the nation Israel to stand apart and bring the other nations to believe in the One, True God. The nation failed, so God sent His Son Jesus Christ to pick those He had chosen to proclaim His kingdom. Peter and Paul are the foundation to proclaim His kingdom and His Church.

Peter was sent to the Jewish nation to share with them that Jesus is the long-awaited Messiah. He preached on the day of Pentecost to bring 3,000 into the Church from the various places around Jerusalem. They heard him talk about the good things that God has done through Jesus. He proclaimed the story of God's love for us and how He was treated and crucified, and how He rose from the dead to conquer death and sin and to give us the possibility of heaven. Peter, the fisherman, spoke with power and conviction to arouse the hearts of those who heard him, and they believed, they were converted, and they became members of the Early Church. They asked what they should do, and they acted on his words to be baptized. Peter saw the

Risen Lord and could not keep it to himself. He spoke what the Holy Spirit put into his heart. He shared the greatest news that has ever come to the earth: God has visited His people. Paul, the "Pharisee of Pharisees" went to the people outside of the House of Israel.

Paul is "The Apostle to the Gentiles." He himself says that he is one born abnormally because of his conversion and seeing Jesus after His resurrection on the road to Damascus. His conversion was an amazing event. God called His followers to welcome Paul, bless him, and impart on him the Holy Spirit. His adventures of the Holy Spirit in the Acts of the Apostles were incredible events of God leading him to do His will and travel to bring the Word of God to the surrounding nations and build communities of believers for the future Church to follow and grow. It is a call for us to be in awe of and to imitate. His words to the communities of the Early Church are shared with us today and we grow in faith by reading and implementing his words to the people who were longing to believe in Jesus. He helped build God's kingdom on earth.

There is a lot to give thanks for in the gift of Peter and Paul. There is a lot to imitate by doing what they did for love of Jesus and thanksgiving for what God shared with them. Our baptismal call and the proclamation at the end of every Mass is that we are to go forth and proclaim the Good News, to go forth in peace and proclaim the Gospel with our lives. May God fill us with the Holy Spirit that we follow His prompting and share Jesus with our neighbors by telling the good that God has done for us!




