## We Are Called...

The familiar Gospel passage of the parable of the Good Samaritan God is reminding us of the Great Commandment and what we are supposed to do to bring out the good of this life. We are called to pay attention to God by what He commands us to serve God by serving our neighbor and how we are to live out thanksgiving for all that He has done for us. In the passage of Deuteronomy, Moses calls the people back to the Lord and for them to heed the Law of the Lord so they can walk with God and be in provision and protection. This is our key to salvation and how we can get the most out of life.

God calls us, and we must respond, with our agreement or rejection of what He created us to be. Free will is not the gift of the Garden of Paradise, it is the gift to choose to love. To give rather than being selfish, to offer life rather than consuming it. This is what God wants to show us and share with us. We are called to be like He is. There are many ways to do this, and we should not reject the opportunity. We must think about how we are going to respond to His love. We need to act on it, not just by saying okay, but doing something to further His kingdom here.

Did you know that we are going to celebrate our 30th anniversary this year? We will celebrate the gift of this church, our community, and the Sacraments that God gives us through it. What is our response to this gift? Are we giving thanks by participating and wanting more? Or are we taking what we can get in an hour and moving on to our next thing, next event, and eager to get there rather than lingering in His Gift of the Body of Christ?

God is not just saying that we should just be passive in our faith, but to proclaim it in the actions of our lives. We are meant to contribute, put something into our worship so we can get something out of it. Put our lives into what we believe. A very powerful lesson from seminary that I have shared before is worth sharing again: Lex Orandi, Lex Credendi, Lex Vivendi (Latin: "the law of what is prayed [is] what is believed [is] the law of what is lived"), this is our Catholic Tradition, and we need to do it! It is the first reading being lived out in our lives in our day. We are present to Moses telling the people to pay attention to the Lord and His Law. He is also speaking to us! We need to decide this day of what is most important in our lives; is it God and His way of living, or is it doing what brings us temporary happiness? Please choose everlasting joy! Do not let the joy of the Lord pass by, do not let the gift of eternal life be on the end of the list of things to do. The only way to see what the Lord has to offer is to get involved, get in the middle of it. "Taste and see that the Lord is good." If you have not yet encountered the Lord in person, try something different, get involved. If you have, keep doing what you are doing and have another taste, have another encounter.
