We Are Called...

This gift of Scripture for this week brings us into the presence of God as He appears to Abraham "while the day was getting hot." It is like Adam's encounter with God as he "walked with God in the cool of the day." It is our action with God that brings us closer to His reality. God uses the stuff of this world to share His goodness and truth with us. Abraham ministered to the three men that were close to his tent. He took care of their needs, and provided food, drink, and comfort for them.

We have the same opportunity to provide for those who come into our lives. If we look beyond ourselves, we can encounter God in front of us in our neighbors. Think of those whom Jesus talked about or ministered to in parables. In the parable of the Prodigal Son, the father celebrated his son's return with a fattened calf. In the parable of the Good Samaritan, the Samaritan man cared for the wounded man and paid for his care at the inn. Like the parable of the Sheep and the Goats, Abraham took care of the three men with food, drink, and shelter from the heat. As Jesus tells us, "When you did it for the least of these brothers of mine, you did it for Me." Are we taking care of those in front of us? We can, and should, take care of Jesus in front of us. We can follow our father Abraham in being joyful and excited about taking care of others. "He hastened into the tent and told Sarah, "Quick, three measures of fine flour." How quickly are we moving to aid strangers? Do we even acknowledge another's needs? If we are, we are listening to God's Word and acting on it, not just hearing and sitting on it or burying it in the ground.

There are many things that we can do for others. Do you like to visit those who cannot come to church? Maybe an elderly member of our parish would like to see your friendly face. Maybe you like to cook? We are starting a new ministry in our parish to help those who have recently had a life event, for example a new baby, or a death in the family, or a surgery. Maybe you would be willing to drive a meal to a family. Maybe you would be interested in taking part in youth ministry by preparing a snack or a meal, talking about your favorite devotion, or even talking about Church in a classroom. Maybe you have an interest in being a chaperone on an outing or talking about where Jesus was present in ministering to the poor or marginalized. We are being called to minister to those around us. We have opportunities to live a life that pleases God and helps our neighbor. We can imitate Abraham and all of those celebrated in Scripture. We can be like the widow of Zarephath, the Sheep of Matthew chapter 25, or the many who have hosted Jesus or a prophet. We can be like Jesus or the 72 that He sent out and take care of multitudes who are in need. We must act on what God teaches and shares with us. We need to do His will and make the world a better place. We need to make this world His kingdom also.




