# We Are Called...

A-S-K. Ask, Seek, Knock. Ask the Lord for the things that you want in your life. Ask for the things other people need in their lives. We are called to intercede for the good so we can see the power of God. We see our dependence on God when we pray for the necessities of life. God wants to be integrated into our lives. He wants us to depend on Him. He wants us to walk with Him.

One of the amazing points of the conversation between Abraham and God is that God was before him. God says that He will go before us. He did it with Abraham, He went before the Israelites as they left Egypt, Jesus goes before us through death into heaven. God wants to walk with us the same way. He wants to go with us to all the places that we travel to so we can take part in the spiritual things that are beyond what we can see and do on our own. He wants us to take part in the life that we can only have with Him, and God does not become tired of us, no matter how much we ask, no matter how often we ask.

Abraham also leads us into another aspect of God and His graciousness. He wants to have conversations with each of us. There are many people who think God does not have time for our desires. Or, our thoughts are too insignificant for Him to be bothered with, or that He does not care, but the opposite is true. He wants us to ask and to take part in all the aspects of His kingdom. He invites us to take part in true life. We need to be like Abraham and find what God wills for our lives. Jesus confirms how we are supposed to converse with God.

Jesus says that we are to ask God to open our lives to what He has for us. Ask, seek, and knock are how we are supposed to approach our Father. Jesus shares the prayer that we are supposed to pray: The Our Father. He continues to share more; it is proper to pray for our daily bread. If we do not ask, should we have the expectation that He will do what is best for us? Look for the best and what God has for us. Seek the things above, not what is below. Seeking means that we must move and look around for what is out there, not just what is inside - looking intently for what is important. Knock and it will be opened to us. If we just walk by a door and expect that someone is on the other side of the door waiting for us, we will miss out on a lot of things. We must put in the effort to meet. We must do the work to win the prize. We must show that we want Christ and His kingdom. If not, why should it be granted to us?

We have many reasons to ask God to take part in our lives, and many things to ask for. We also are given many opportunities to take part in God's work in this world, just like Abraham. It comes down to what do we want. "Seek ye first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all of these things will be given to you besides." What do you want? What are you asking for? How do you want God to take part in your life? Ask and you will receive.

**Holy Angels is excited to offer Children's Choir as a ministry to children in grades 2-6.**

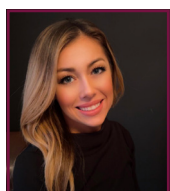
