We Are Called...

Jesus came to set the world on fire and knew this would cause division! That is what He shares with us in Luke chapter 12. Often, people think of Jesus as meek and mild, “Gentle Jesus,” but He is the One to lead His chosen people to heaven. Think of who Jesus is. Hear the words that He is proclaiming. He is saying that we need to make a choice.

The choice that we need to make is the most significant choice of our lives. It is the choice that affects everything for the rest of our lives. If we choose Jesus, then we may have to be at odds with those who do not choose Him. We would be at odds with our family members, maybe our brother, sister, or even our husband, wife, or children. Yes, our lives with Jesus are that serious and significant! We must choose and take it to heart. We are either in or out, a member of His group and work for His kingdom, or we are on the outside and oppose His kingdom. There is no other choice. We cannot just say that we are not going to choose. God is not calling us to watch the rest of the world being for or against Him, because just watching is not doing what He says or what He wants for us. If we are not in the fold, and we are watching to see how things turn out, we miss out. There is no other way, and He is wanting us to grow in relationship with Him.

Jesus is calling us into something special, a relationship with the living God. He wants us to choose Him over our job, friends, and even our family. There are people who want things other than a relationship with God. They may seek worldly things or want something over God in their lives.

Maybe it is baseball, golf, a position in the company, or even someone to love them in a marriage. Well, Jesus puts all of this in perspective even if we do not agree or if we want to believe otherwise. Truth is Truth regardless of whether we believe it or not. Just because we want things to be different, we cannot make it so. God wants a relationship with us. Do we want a relationship with Him? Will we place Him in first place in our lives? Will He be the center of our lives? He deserves our love because He first loved us.

He deserves our best, and He must be the One unnegotiable in our lives, even if we think that we love someone who “Makes our day or makes us feel special.” What does the God of the universe want for us? He wants us to realize how much He loves us, and wants us to love Him in return, in thanksgiving, and in truth. We can make the choice to love Him more than anything else, or we can choose to love something above Him, but if we look with the eyes of faith, and look for what allows us to enter heaven, we will choose Christ. He leaves this up to us because if we are to love, WE must put action on our words, thoughts, and beliefs.

He came to set the world on fire. This fire is the fire of love, His love, and He wants us to put Him into everything that we do and speak. Allow Him to be a part of all that we do, even if it creates a division between our loved ones.

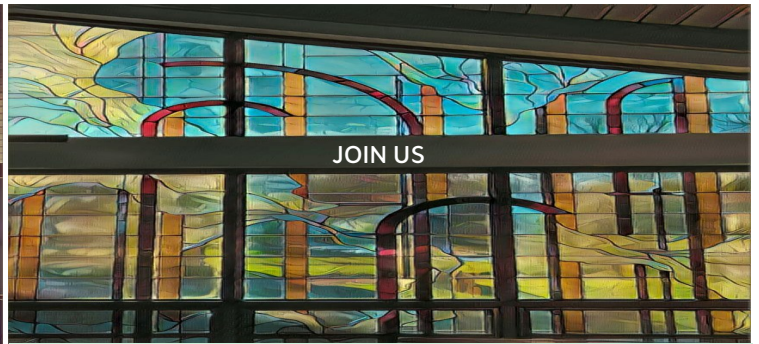

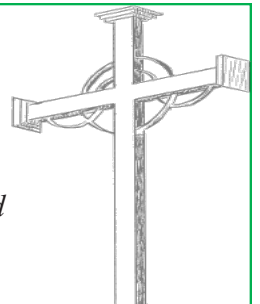

Registration Now Open for Family First PSR Classes

Registration is open until Tuesday, September 9th. No late registrations will be accepted. There will be a Mandatory Parent Meeting on Wednesday, September 10th at 6pm. You must be registered by September 9th. Classes are offered on Monday and Tuesday again this year from 4:45pm to 6pm. Scan the QR code to register.



What is PSR Plus?

Holy Angels is excited to offer Children's Choir as a ministry to children in grades 2-6. Choir is held from 6pm to 6:45pm in the Worship Space on Mondays that there are PSR classes. If your child is home-schooled or attends class on Tuesday, they are still welcome to participate in choir by coming on Mondays at 6pm! Choir is a ministry, not a club, and as a part of this ministry students are expected to sing on two occasions per semester. In December, the children will sing at the annual Christmas concert (Sunday, December 7th at 3pm with dress rehearsal the day before-Saturday, December 6th at 1pm) and Christmas Eve at the 4pm Mass. In the spring, the children will sing on Easter Sunday at the 11am Mass, and for the group First Communion (Saturday, April 25th at 10am).
