

## We Are Called...

We celebrate the Feast of Christ the King as the end of the liturgical year and the holiday of Thanksgiving this week. They have something in common. The gift of Christ as our King is the greatest reason for thanksgiving. In fact, the thanks that we give in the celebration of the Mass is the Gift of Christ in the Eucharist, which means thanksgiving. It is the opportunity to recognize the things that we take for granted and the things that should matter most.

What are you thankful for? That list is probably pretty long because we could give thanks for a plethora of things and as we go through our day, keep giving thanks. What are you most thankful for? This list may be a few things or maybe one thing. When this question is asked, many people will answer with “my spouse” or something significant that has happened in their lives. Fewer people would say that they are most thankful for God, or their relationship with God. Whenever I think of thanksgiving, I am reminded to give thanks For the Giver, not just the gift. We can receive gifts and acts of kindness every day, we often offer thanks for what someone has done, whether gift or action, but do we give thanks for the one that shared? We should direct thanks to the one that thought of us enough to share kindness, not just for the act of kindness. It is like being most thankful for the person closest to us in our lives, a spouse or a very close friend. Jesus wants to be that for us. He wants us to want Him in our lives like that. He wants to show us how much He loves us. We should be grateful for His love and care for us.

Grateful for the gift and the Giver.  
Thank You, Jesus! Thank You for loving me.  
Thank You for...? Jesus Christ King of the Universe cares for each one of us individually and intimately. He wants us to recognize that He is present to us and is always wanting to aid us in this life so we can cooperate with grace to build a

relationship of love. He is in the whole act of thanksgiving and love from His gift initiating, giving, receiving, gratitude, and reception of the person. We grow in love through gratitude. We grow in knowledge and love of the person.

Jesus gives us Himself in the Eucharist as the most perfect thanksgiving possible. He becomes the Altar, the Priest, and the Offering. We have been given the act of offering thanks to God from God Himself. He wants a sacrifice of thanksgiving for His participation in our lives. We have done this from the time that He offered His promise to Adam and Eve in the garden of Eden. He gave them animal skins to cover themselves, which becomes the first sacrifice. Cain and Able offer sacrifice to God in thanksgiving for their harvest, their increase of gift in their lives. Abraham offers bread and wine as a sacrifice with Melchizedek. God starts a covenant with Him with animals as He passes a torch and bowl between the pieces. The act of thanksgiving is shared throughout scripture. Jesus gives us the Perfect Thanksgiving in the Eucharist. We should offer this Gift of thanks to God for all that He does as often as possible. We do this in the celebration of the Mass. Jesus gives us everything that we need to give God thanks. What are you thankful for? May we give thanks for the One who first loved us. May we be grateful for the King of the Universe that calls us constantly into relationship with Him. May we be aware of giving thanks to those who show us kindness. May we live lives of gratitude for everything that comes to us. As we celebrate Thanksgiving, may we be mindful of all the things that we take for granted, especially for the people in our lives that we take for granted. Thank You, Jesus!





## OCIA NEWS

### What is a Candidate?

"Adult Catholics who, having been baptized as infants, did not afterwards receive catechesis, and therefore have not received Confirmation and the Eucharist. It may, however, be adapted to similar cases, especially that of an adult who was baptized in danger of or at the point of death, or who was validly baptized in another Christian community." Even if adults in this situation have not yet heard the proclamation of the mystery of Christ, their circumstance nonetheless differs from the circumstance of catechumens because they have already been brought into the Church and become children of God by Baptism. Hence their conversion is based on Baptism already received, the strength of which they should further develop." OCIA #400





## Oplatki


Oplatki are available for a suggested donation of \$2. Stop by the Information Desk to purchase.

For centuries on Christmas Eve, families in Poland, Lithuania, and the Czech and Slav Republics have practiced a beautiful tradition. It is the breaking and sharing of the Oplatek - Christmas Wafer. Oplatek—taken from the Latin word *oblatum* (means Sacred Bread), has been the symbol of Christianity and Jesus Christ, our Bread of Life.

On the Holiest Night of the year, a festive 12-course meatless dinner is prepared for the gathered family and friends. An extra setting is placed for a beggar (our Lord) who may come to the door, or a poor family (the Holy Family) looking for a place to stay. The host or hostess leads the group in a special prayer and distributes an oplatek to the participants. Each person breaks off a piece of the other's oplatek and continues until they have exchanged good wishes and blessings with everyone. Traditionally, at Midnight, the head of the household takes the pink oplatek and shares it with the animals on his farm or at his home. This custom brings us back to the Holy Night when even animals were able to speak, and to remind us that we are all God's creatures.
