## We Are Called...

It is that time again. Time to get ready for and focus on Christmas. It is the time to prepare for the coming of the Lord Jesus Christ. We have four weeks before Christmas; what will you do with the time you have before the day that we celebrate the birth of Jesus? As we celebrate the beginning of the new liturgical year, we start with preparing for the beginning of the Greatest Event that has happened on the face of the earth. We celebrate the beginning of something new. We celebrate a deeper relationship with Jesus.

Christmas has become a holiday for all and not a Holy Day for all. The world is trying to turn Christmas into a commercialized day to turn our attention to worldly things and focus on things that revolve around money, gift giving and receiving, and things that do not raise our attention to heavenly things. We focus on gifts, cookies, dinner, gathering families and friends, and decorations. These things are important and are worth putting time and effort into, but often, we leave out the most important person of the holy day, because the things that we do have taken precedence in our minds. We are called to celebrate the birth of Jesus. To make and do all those things with Jesus in mind, in thanksgiving for Him, and for the blessing of His participation in our lives. We should do these things in gratitude for the One who has come into the world and into our lives to recreate us and change us to be better than we would be without Him. We are called to be another Christ in the world so others may know Him.

We celebrate all that happened before His life on earth and everything that He brought into the world. All the things that we do for Christmas should be in imitation of Jesus and His Church for the good of the world, our neighbors and friends,

and our families. We must bring Jesus into our hearts and lives that He may take part in all the activities of our lives. It is the preparation for the rest of our year and the rest of our lives.

Advent is the beginning of our liturgical year, and the beginning of a new encounter with Jesus. We are preparing for God to transform our lives to become more present and active in the things that we do. We are called to be more like Saint Nicholas, Santa Claus. He went around doing good and cared for others. We imitate what he did in our Christmas celebrations but are we doing it with the same mindfulness of Jesus? He was serving God through serving others. He found people to help and bring a better life for them. He took care of their need so they may give thanks to God for what he did. How can we be like Saint Nicholas? We have opportunities in our parish to do something in thanksgiving for all that God has done for us. We celebrate our thanks by being for others what God has been for us. We have Giving Trees with items to buy for ministries in the greater area to aid them with helping those in need. We have an "Adopt a Family for Christmas" opportunity to get a little more personal by helping a family celebrate Christmas with dignity and joy. We can find other ways of giving Jesus in the season of newness. Take advantage of doing one thing more in thanksgiving for God coming into your life. One thing to grow closer in the relationship that He wants with us. He came into our world to come into our lives. What is that worth to you? How will you show your love for Him?



## Oplatki

Oplatki are available for a suggested donation of \$2. Stop by the Information Desk to purchase.

For centuries on Christmas Eve, families in Poland, Lithuania, and the Czech and Slav Republics have practiced a beautiful tradition. It is the breaking and sharing of the Oplatek—Christmas Wafer. Oplatek—taken from the Latin word *oblatum* (means Sacred Bread)—has been the symbol of Christianity and Jesus Christ, our Bread of Life.

On the Holiest Night of the year, a festive 12-course meatless dinner is prepared for the gathered family and friends. An extra setting is placed for a beggar (our Lord) who may come to the door, or a poor family (the Holy Family) looking for a place to stay. The host or hostess leads the group in a special prayer and distributes an oplatek to the participants. Each person breaks off a piece of the other's oplatek and continues until they have exchanged good wishes and blessings with everyone. Traditionally, at Midnight, the head of the household takes the pink oplatek and shares it with the animals on his farm or at his home. This custom brings us back to the Holy Night when even animals were able to speak, and to remind us that we are all God's creatures.


## SAINT THÉRÈSE MINISTRY

The Coordinator will then mail the package.
