

We Are Called...

It is already the Second Sunday of Advent! We are quickly moving to the Christmas season and have a few more weeks to prepare for the Best Event of our lives. One of the blessings of Advent is to work through the Book of Isaiah. It shares the prophecy of the Messiah and what we should expect in the time of the Lord. The blessing of anticipating the Lord being present to us is itself a great blessing. We can get excited about seeing the prophecies take place in the past and the present.

The Lord has blessed His people with all the things that John the Baptist proclaimed and those written in the Book of Isaiah, but what about now? What happens as we journey toward Christmas? Do we recognize or even anticipate the coming of the Lord? We are called to look for the Lord. This time of Advent is an opportunity to focus on Him. We can concentrate on the past, and His coming as a babe in the manger, but He wants us to take part in the Second Coming of the King of the Universe. We must act out the preaching of John the Baptist and "Make straight our paths." We need to turn our way of life into the way of Christ.

We can do all that we can for the growing of our faith and relationship with the Lord. We need to come to the place that we proclaim the words of Saint Thomas the Apostle, "My Lord and my God." We need to make Him ours, and we need to be His. We must walk into the way of Christ, and the Second Sunday of Advent directs our attention to do what we need to become one of His own. To let God be God for us. The second Sunday calls us to recognize His Power and Glory. He brings a plethora of benefits into our lives and transforms us into who He created us to be when we walk in His

way. Isaiah and John the Baptist tell us why Jesus is coming into the world, to bring His reign of power and peace, justice and love, righteousness and truth. He is coming to turn the world right side up.

"The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light." Many are comfortable walking where they are, how they are, just doing what is before them, not taking part in the things of God here and now. God came to earth as one of us to show us more than we meet on the surface.

What will this Advent bring for you? What gift is God trying to offer to you as you prepare for the coming of His Only Begotten Son? Maybe He is sharing the Gift of everlasting life and letting you take part in it now. We can be consumed by all the Stuff that we get involved in as we prepare for an earthly Christmas and we miss the reality of the eternal Christmas, the Divine Word that came into the Spirit of Truth and all that is shared through Isaiah and John. It is the season to want more of God in our lives, to want a better life that lasts long after this life ends. The truth is that we will live after death, the question is where and how we will live. In darkness or in the Light? Will we live with God for eternity, or will we live wanting to be there. This is the time to think of all of what will come or what will be. Now is the time to enter what God has for us. It is not enough to walk in ignorance of Christ; we must walk in His truth and want all that He has for us. It is time to recognize and accept the Gift of God and act on it. Walk as a Child of the Light. Enjoy His life, so we may have eternal life.






