

We Are Called...

We celebrate Gaudete Sunday and the third week of Advent. We look toward the joy of the coming of Christ. In the middle of our preparation season, we are blessed with attention given to the joy that comes on the day of the Lord's birth. We rejoice for the Lord is near, His coming in the flesh is approaching quickly. Rejoice because His blessing is in His presence and He wants us to take part in it. He will bring good to those who suffer and have burdens. We can be like John the Baptist and have doubts.

Think of who John the Baptist is. He is the cousin of Jesus. He leaped in his mother's womb when Mary went to visit Elizabeth after her conversation with the angel Gabriel. He announced to the people gathered at the Jordan River, "Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world." He said to Jesus that He should be baptizing him, not him baptizing Jesus. He knows who Jesus is, and yet he has a question. He wonders if Jesus is the fulfillment of God's Promise of the Savior. He wants to know if Jesus will fulfill all the prophecies of the prophets. John is in prison and is questioning his freedom. John is asking if Jesus is going to free him from prison. Often, we question whether Jesus knows that we need His help. There are times when we ask others to seek Jesus for help. We also need to know His divine will. This is a reason for joy and hope. This is the celebration of Gaudete Sunday.

The Third Sunday of Advent, we have Jesus and John the Baptist in the forefront of the Gospel. We are entering a transition of focus. John is decreasing his presence, and Jesus is coming into His ministry to pour out His power, glory, and love on

the world. The beginning of His ministry is asking others why they went to the desert. What did they expect? Jesus explains the person of John and what he came to do. He accomplished his mission, and he wonders if Jesus is the Messiah because of Isaiah's writing about what He would come to do. We rejoice because we anticipate His coming and we believe in the writing of what He will do. We must have eager anticipation for His coming and the work that He will do.

The mission for us today is to share what we know about the coming of the Lord. We must share the blessing of knowing with others. We are called to bring the presence of Jesus to all whom we meet. We need to make room for the Lord in our lives and share Him. How has Jesus changed your life? Does celebrating His gift of a Church, the Blessed Sacrament, and becoming the Body of Christ change how you live your life? It should and we should consider it a privilege to bless others with a knowledge and love of God.

As children we are taught a lesson of sharing with others. We may remember that "Sharing is caring," and many other ways of learning that we should give some of what we have with people around us. Hopefully, we have learned this and practice this all the time. Share the Greatest Gift in the World: Jesus!

Meet Victor Vitale



Throughout high school and college, I would have described myself as an atheist. After graduating, I began listening to and talking with two gentlemen whom I consider grandfather figures, sparking a curiosity about God and spiritual matters. I gradually became agnostic.

After several years, two major experiences led me toward Holy Angels. The first was meeting my now-fiancée, Katie, and the second was listening to Jordan Peterson's Exodus and Gospel seminars. While listening to those seminars, I felt a calling intellectually and spiritually to begin attending church. At first, I planned to try a Protestant church such as Silver Creek or Parkside. But one Sunday, Katie, who grew up Catholic at Holy Angels but hadn't been attending regularly, suggested we come here instead.

I am very excited to be baptized and confirmed as a Catholic, and I look forward to growing further in both faith and community. End-of-the-Year Reminder for Those with IRAs

For those who are 72 years old and older, the required minimum distribution (RMD) from an IRA for each year must be taken by year-end. If a check is written directly to a charity of your choice, taxable income to the donor is not created nor is a charitable contribution allowed on the individual's federal tax return. Charitable contributions directly from an IRA account are referred to as a "qualified charitable contribution" on the individual's federal income tax return. Contributions to charities are not limited to the amount of RMD. Your IRA Charitable Rollover Gift will not only benefit Holy Angels but may benefit you by meeting your annual required minimum distribution and reducing your taxable income. These transfers are income tax-free so long as the gift is made by December 31. Consider an IRA Charitable Rollover transfer to benefit your parish family. Contact your financial advisor to see if the IRA Charitable Rollover is a good option for you. If interested, please contact Don Maar in the Parish Office.

Oplatki ~ are available for a suggested donation of \$2. Stop by the Information Desk to purchase.

For centuries on Christmas Eve, families in Poland, Lithuania, and the Czech and Slav Republics have practiced a beautiful tradition. It is the breaking and sharing of the Oplatek - Christmas Wafer. Oplatek - taken from the Latin word *oblatum* (means Sacred Bread) - has been the symbol of Christianity and Jesus Christ, our Bread of Life.

On the Holiest Night of the year, a festive 12-course meatless dinner is prepared for the gathered family and friends. An extra setting is placed for a beggar (our Lord) who may come to the door, or a poor family (the Holy Family) looking for a place to stay. The host or hostess leads the group in a special prayer and distributes an oplatek to the participants. Each person breaks off a piece of the other's oplatek and continues until they have exchanged good wishes and blessings with everyone.

Traditionally, at Midnight, the head of the household takes the pink oplatek and shares it with the animals on his farm or at his home. This custom brings us back to the Holy Night when even animals were able to speak, and to remind us that we are all God's creatures.


