



Merry Christmas!

May the blessing of Jesus Christ be yours this Christmas season! May the Joy of Christmas be the Gift that you give to all who you meet, and may His love be a part of your life forever! How do you celebrate Christmas? What are your traditions? I would like to offer another tradition to share with your loved ones as you continue to celebrate Christmas your way.

There are many traditions in celebrating Christmas and Christmas Eve. Many Italian homes spend Christmas Eve with the celebration of Feast of the Seven Fishes. The tradition of a meatless meal where only seafood is served. Then off to midnight Mass, and several other things. Another cultural tradition may be a Dutch Christmas, where the celebration starts on December 5, to celebrate Sinterklaasavond, Saint Nicholas Eve. Shoes and treats, “Sooty Piet” or elves, help Saint Nicholas deliver treats to good kids. A second celebration happens on the day after! Then there are two celebrations for Christmas, but both of those are primarily about visiting family. Many cultural traditions are about faith, family, and food. I like to add the other two F’s of friends and fun into the mix, because they are important, too. Whatever your traditions are, they are significant ways to build memories in your family. Maybe your tradition is having a special food or doing a particular activity, these recurring things make memories.

This is what I would like you to add to your traditions. It has a parallel to the Dutch tradition of celebrating Saint Nicholas Day and Christmas, as well as the Italian tradition of Christmas Eve. They build on Faith, Family, and Food. It is having

more than one day to celebrate the gift of being present rather than just giving presents. Saint Nicholas and Jesus are real people and celebrating their gifts to the world deserves more than one visit to a church, just like the multiple events that happen in their culture. What they do is based in the Catholic Church, like not eating meat on Christmas Eve, or celebrating *Saint* Nicholas. It would be wonderful if we all incorporated the Christmas *Season* into our traditions and memories.

Several opportunities are when we celebrate the Holy Family on the Sunday after Christmas, the Feast of Mary, the Mother of God, on New Year’s Day the celebration of the various saints through the season, the Feast of the Epiphany the second Sunday after Christmas, or the Baptism of the Lord on the third Sunday after Christmas. We have the opportunity to make more of the Christmas season, than one or two days a year. We spend time, money, and effort to make Christmas special. It would be even more fantastic if we made more memories with our families and friends around the grace of God bringing good into our lives. The sacrifice of Jesus coming to earth from heaven, becoming human, dying on a cross to forgive our sins, and to show us the love of our Father. Traditions and memories connect us together through time. Many of us remember the things that we did growing up, continuing them year after year transforms our lives. Faith, Family, and Food are the vehicles that move us to build those things that transform our lives. Make the most of what we are given. Make more of the opportunities to celebrate the good that God presents to us. Let God be more of the celebration.

Angel Scholarship Fund

Through the Angel Scholarship Fund, you can now contribute funds that will be used to provide tuition assistance for students to attend our Catholic schools, and you will receive a 100% Ohio income tax credit of up to \$750 against your 2025 state tax liability. Oplatki ~ are available for a suggested donation of \$2. Stop by the Information Desk to purchase.

For centuries on Christmas Eve, families in Poland, Lithuania, and the Czech and Slav Republics have practiced a beautiful tradition. It is the breaking and sharing of the Oplatek - Christmas Wafer. Oplatek - taken from the Latin word *oblatum* (means Sacred Bread) - has been the symbol of Christianity and Jesus Christ, our Bread of Life.

On the Holiest Night of the year, a festive 12-course meatless dinner is prepared for the gathered family and friends. An extra setting is placed for a beggar (our Lord) who may come to the door, or a poor family (the Holy Family) looking for a place to stay. The host or hostess leads the group in a special prayer and distributes an oplatek to the participants. Each person breaks off a piece of the other's oplatek and continues until they have exchanged good wishes and blessings with everyone.

Traditionally, at Midnight, the head of the household takes the pink oplatek and shares it with the animals on his farm or at his home. This custom brings us back to the Holy Night when even animals were able to speak, and to remind us that we are all God's creatures.

End-of-the-Year Reminder for Those with IRAs

For those who are 72 years old and older, the required minimum distribution (RMD) from an IRA for each year must be taken by year-end. If a check is written directly to a charity of your choice, taxable income to the donor is not created nor is a charitable contribution allowed on the individual's federal tax return. Charitable contributions directly from an IRA account are referred to as a "qualified charitable contribution" on the individual's federal income tax return. Contributions to charities are not limited to the amount of RMD. Your IRA Charitable Rollover Gift will not only benefit Holy Angels but may benefit you by meeting your annual required minimum distribution and reducing your taxable income. These transfers are income tax-free so long as the gift is made by December 31. Consider an IRA Charitable Rollover transfer to benefit your parish family. Contact your financial advisor to see if the IRA Charitable Rollover is a good option for you. If interested, please contact Don Maar in the Parish Office.
