

We Are Called...



That was an amazing Christmas season! I hope that you had the best Christmas ever! God always showers us with gifts and is especially generous during the seasons of grace at Christmas and Easter. Now we are given time to live out the grace that was shared with us, and it was a lot. Ordinary Time is this opportunity, and this year is the moment that we as a community are going on a journey to do one thing to enjoy our relationship with God more deeply than ever before, and to grow as a community to support one another and grow spiritually together. All it takes is “Just One Step” and we will be able to “Walk with One.” As a community, we are going to deepen our love of God, become more comfortable in our faith and share it with others.

These two initiatives are the two steps that will help us change how comfortable we are with truly living out our faith in the world. For us to live as Christ Followers, Catholics, and live out our Baptism. When we were baptized, we became as a member of Christ, Priest, Prophet, and King. As parents and godparents, we say that we will raise the person baptized in the ways of the faith being the best of teachers to share with them the faith that was shared with us, we show them what it means to be a Catholic. We teach them the practice of being with God. This is the idea of “Walk with One.” Practicing the faith and sharing what we do and how we do it with the child or person entrusted to us to lead them to have a relationship with God. Please do not think of this as a cliché or overly familiar words that have little meaning, because they are the purpose of our lives.

We are called to know, love, and serve the Lord as the reason we were made. It is our privilege

and responsibility to live this and to teach this to those entrusted to us. This means children, family, friends, and as Jesus says, our neighbor. If we love God, and place our trust in Him, we will want to share Him with our neighbors and tell all the wonderful things He has done for us. We will want to fill the world with His love and Joy. He has pursued us from the beginning and has a desire for us to join Him in heaven for eternity. He gave Adam animal skin to cover himself after he sinned. This is an act of love. To consider the need for another instead of focusing on the wrong that was done. To offer a way back to reconciliation and a return to relationship. This is what God wants us to share with our neighbor, The Way back to God, and we first need to experience it in our lives, then share it.

This is the root of “Just One Step.” We need to experience the love of God. we need to know and have the reality of a relationship with God, that it is possible to love and be loved by God because He wants it for us. Even if we are comfortable with where we are in our relationship with Christ, we can grow. Saint Paul relates the marriage of a man and woman to our relationship with God and His Church. It mirrors our relationship with one another. We are called to sacrifice and to take part in sharing the possibility of experiencing the spiritual reality of God in our daily activities and in our relationships with others. We must take part in the work of God because this is where we encounter God. By working beside Him, we get to see His power, love, care, glory, and every other aspect of Him. We grow in grace and knowing Him so we can love Him more.


