

We Are Called...



This is an awesome week to be part of this parish! This week is a reminder of what we are called to be in this world and how we can take part in God's kingdom. There are little hints for us to pay attention to in the readings, and especially this gospel passage from Matthew. God is sharing that He will take care of those who want to walk with Him. God does not say, "Sit and wait for Me to come again." No, He says that we need to be aligned with Him in being active in this world to encounter Him and to be with Him. Our attitude is the start; our activity is the fulfilment of His kingdom. Humility and justice are what we should be rooted in.

Zephaniah tells us that we need to seek justice and seek humility and perhaps we will be sheltered in the day of the Lord. The remnant will be taken care of by the Lord. This is our reminder that we must follow His command if we are to be under His protection and provision. To encounter peace and grace in our lives, we must let God be God for us and submit to His will for us. God promised that He would take care of His people and shepherd His flock. We need to give Him room to do it.

Saint Paul tells us and the Corinthians that those who are not of the world and are not regarded as of high status in the world are the ones that God will use for His kingdom. We do not need to strive for the things that the world holds in high regard, but we need to be stewards of God to minister to those in the margins and to be witnesses in the world of His power. We do not need a certain education or have a level of understanding to be able to serve, because God will give us everything that we need to do His will and His work.

In the Gospel of Matthew, Jesus sees the

crowds, He sits down, and His disciples come to Him. The crowds do not gather close to Him, they are just in the distance, not looking to get close, they just do not want to miss anything. His disciples came close enough to hear Him. They came with expectation. We need to do the same. We need to come to Him. As we come to celebrate the Eucharist, we should have expectations to be with Him and to be transformed. We are called to be His disciples, and we need to imitate this nugget of grace. There were many that just wanted to be in the vicinity, they did not want to be intimate like His disciples. Are we comfortable with our relationship with the Lord?

In the story of The Man Born Blind in the Gospel of John, the blind man asks the pharisees, "Do you want to be one of His disciples also?" Their answer is that they are disciples of Moses, but Moses was connected to God, they talked with one another, they only followed rules and laws. We need to be like that man who wanted a relationship with Jesus. We have a plethora of examples of people that had special relationships with God. Which one are we going to imitate? Who are we like? What do we want our God-relationship to be? It is up to us to work on it, develop it, nurture it. What are you going to do to make it happen? Now is the time, this is the place to get started and get it going. All it takes is "**Just One Step.**" Keep your *eyes* and *ears* open because we are going to do just that, we are going to take just one step. We are on a journey to heaven, and we get there through relationship. This is an opportunity to do it together.
