

We Are Called...



We are called to grow in our actions of faith. The Book of Isaiah tells us twice to “share our bread with the hungry.” Paul shares that he did not come with any human power or wisdom, but with understanding and sharing one thing: “Jesus Christ, and Him crucified.” Jesus tells those gathered around Him about being salt and light, and what their purpose is. We extract our purpose in this world by being salt and light for others and to take care of one another in our actions and sharing the wisdom and knowledge of God.

The Baltimore Catechism has a well-known answer to why we were born: “To know, love, and serve the Lord in this life so we can love Him in the next.” We have a plethora of opportunities in our parish to know, love, and serve Him. We have had and will have book studies from the Bible to understanding the Mass and the Eucharist. We have opportunities to serve the Lord in the various ministries in our parish. We have regular “We Can” collections, Saint Pat’s Hunger Center meals to make and serve to the less fortunate in our larger community, and many other things to take part in. We have been blessed with people who take the words of scripture to heart and are living out the words that God is speaking to us. Thank you for your activity and for listening to what God has imparted on you to share with us. You are being salt and light to us. We can look at bread in several ways.

We hear the words of Isaiah to share our bread with the hungry, but how do we understand bread and hunger? If we only think of bread as the product of grain being crushed and mixed and cooked, then we are being short sighted, because Jesus tells a parable about The Seed and the Sower

where He explains the seed is the Word of God and the soil types are those who hear it. He shares this way of seeing bread with us that we would be active in it as well. He calls those listening to produce 30, 60, or 100-fold. The Word of God is to bear a harvest for the Lord. Bearing fruit is the activity that we have from implementing the message of God in our lives. The fruit can be evangelizing to our neighbors by sharing how the message affected our lives, bringing joy, peace, or truth into our lives. Or by doing any of the activities in the Gospel of Matthew Chapter 25 to our neighbors, or many other ways.

We often pray “Give us this day our daily bread.” Is this only the bread that will fill our bellies? No, because in the Gospel of John Chapter 6, Jesus fed the 5000 with five loaves and two fish. “They ate and were satisfied.” Their hearts were filled as well as their bellies. They experienced something beyond their understanding. Our experience of Jesus in the Mass and in our lives is supposed to be what they had. This is what we are to carry into our lives for the rest of the week and into the lives of people that we will meet. Changing their lives is being salt and light, it is bearing fruit for God.

As salt and light, we help others see more of life and taste more of the goodness of life. We give them a glimpse and encounter of God which will hopefully leave them wanting more, just like the 5000! We must do something to know, love, and serve the Lord more than we do now. We need to take Just One Step toward the Lord our God.
