
Blessed Sacrament School Family Guild Newsletter November 2022



A Letter from Bishop Byrne:

In the church calendar, the month of November begins with solemnity because of the celebrations of All Saints Day on the First and All Souls Day on the Second. The entire month is, of course, the month of the holy souls, in which we are reminded of our duty to remember our deceased loved ones and to pray for their passage from purgatory.

The opportunity to remember and honor two beloved priests came early this year, because October 15th marked the unveiling of the street signs dedicated to Msgrs. Finn and Berardi. The Blessed Sacrament community was enveloped in sadness at the beginning of 2022, but the various tributes that were given that day helped all to recall the way that these exemplary priests touched the lives of so many. May they rest in peace.

Blessed Sacrament was graced recently with the presence of our Archbishop, Cardinal Dolan, who visited the school on October 24th in connection with Borough President Fossella's grant that will assist sports programs throughout the Catholic school community. His Eminence was positively impressed by the appearance of the school and the deportment of its students.

November includes the great feast of Thanksgiving, a beautiful American tradition that acknowledges the unique blessings that God has showered on our homeland. For Catholics, the most exalted expression of gratitude is the Holy Mass, since the word "Eucharist" means thanksgiving. Daily prayers, preferably as a family and faithful attendance at Sunday Mass are the foundations of Catholic life. May they flourish in the Blessed Sacrament community always, and in particular during the month of November when we give thanks to God and call to mind our final destination in heaven.

On Saturday October 15, 2022, the street corner of Manor Road and Forest Avenue was dedicated to our deeply beloved former Pastors Monsignor Peter Finn and Monsignor Ferdinando Berardi. Both continue to be strong influences on our parish and school through the impact they had during their time with us and the legacy they both leave behind. We are honored to have their names grade our bordering streets, serving as a constant reminder of their love and service.






A Letter from our President:
