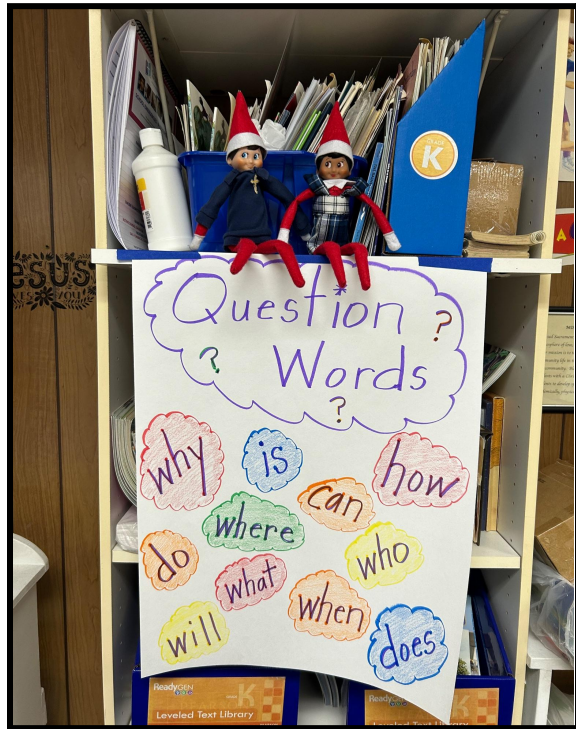


Hi everyone!

One of the best parts of being at Blessed Sacrament is all we have learned each year that we are here!

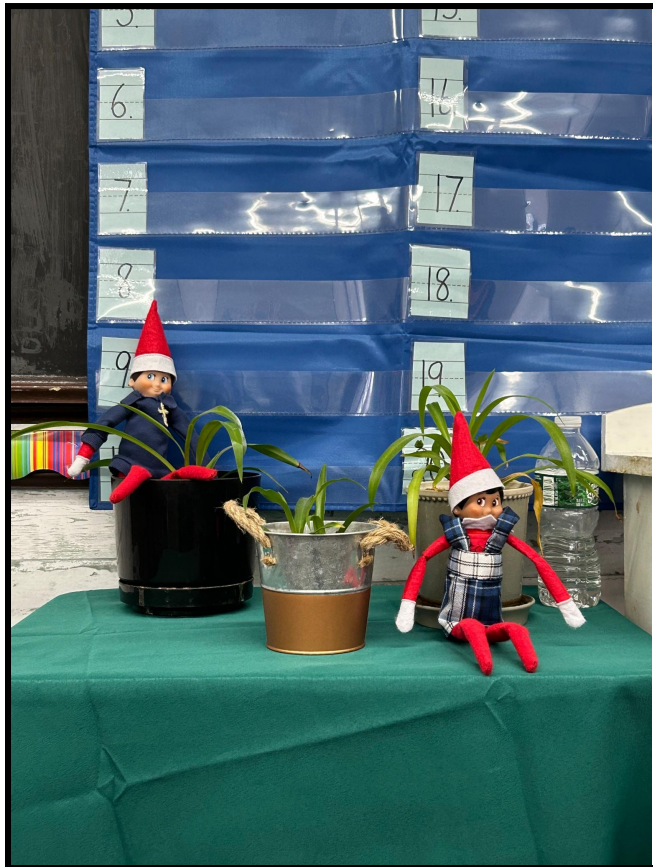


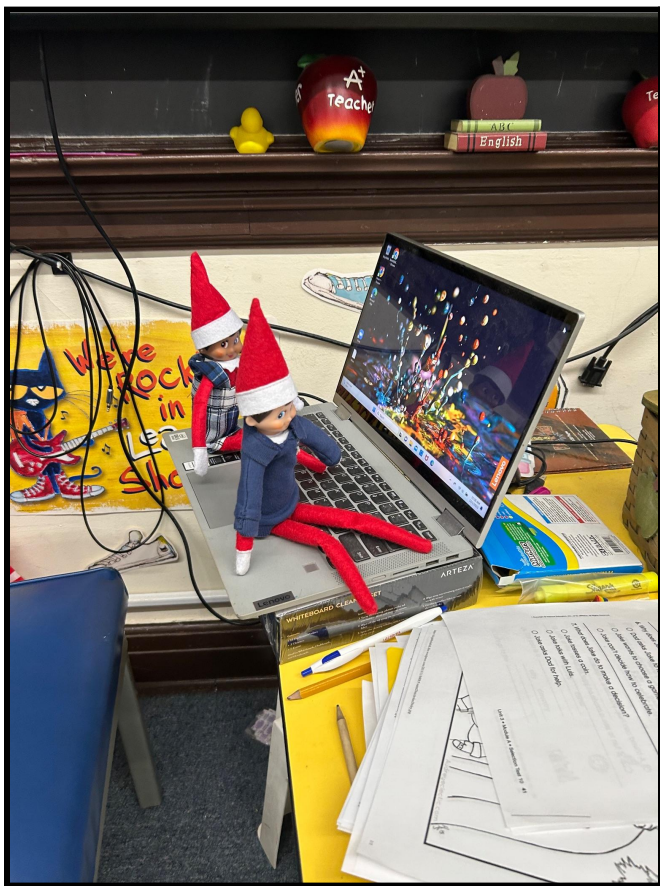
Asking questions is a wonderful way to learn! K-1 had some great question words for us to use as we went around the school. We can show you some of the places we visited and some of the questions that we asked!
