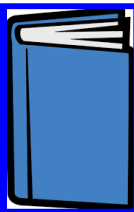
SVDP St. Angela Merici Food Cupboard

Title: Director of Music/Liturgy

Purpose: We are looking for a person to join our parish team with talent and enthusiasm to continue to develop and support the worship and prayerfulness of our faith community at Saint Angela Merici.

Goals:

- * To develop a prayerful faith community through celebration, preparation, and evaluation, through education and personal ministry.
- * With the cooperation and assistance of all the parish ministers, the Director of Music/Liturgy will support the gospel message through song, music, and worship, and will challenge the faith community to live the Gospel message more fully.
- * To build and sustain congregational singing.
- * To increase regular attendance at liturgies through the quality of the music/liturgy.
- * To recruit, train, and sustain cantors for the various liturgies.
- * To recruit, train, and sustain choirs for the various liturgies.
- * To recruit, train, and sustain instrumentalists for various liturgies.

Qualifications:

- * Musical ability and be accomplished and skillful in choral direction, rhythm, tempo, harmony, melody, etc.
- * Suitable experience in the performance of sacred music.
- * Knowledge of Sacred Liturgy, current music, and principles for selection of music for Roman Catholic worship.
- * Possess a good theology of Catholic Liturgy and music for the Church since the Second Vatican Council.
- * A ministerial attitude.
- * A prayerful approach to music and liturgy.
- * The ability to foster and nourish faith.
- * The ability to lead the faith community as well as the choir.
- * Skill in piano/keyboard performance of Sacred Music.
- * Skill in preparing worship aids for various liturgies as needed.
- * Functional knowledge of technology.

Responsibilities:

- * **Oversee music selection, preparation, and choir practices for all liturgies at Saint Angela Merici Parish.**
- * **Schedule additional instrumentalists, cantor, and singers as needed.**
- * **Train and rehearse cantors, the choir, and the faith community in new music, as needed.**
- * **Provide piano/keyboard music and necessary choral music for the weekend, Saturday and Sunday Masses, as well as the following additional services during the year: Advent, Christmas, Lent, Holy Week, Easter, Holy Days of Obligation, Weddings, Funerals, Reconciliation Services, Parish Missions, Confirmation, First Holy Communion, and special parish events such as para-liturgical Advent and Lenten programs of music., etc.**
- * **Cooperate in the area of general planning and leadership of the parish's music/liturgy program.**
- * **Be responsible for the purchase of all necessary music and music supplies and the hiring of instrumental and vocal soloists when required, with the approval of the Pastor.**
- * **Evaluate the parish worship aids and after proper study, present to the Pastor recommendations for improvement in the parish liturgies.**
- * **Be a resource for the bride and groom in selecting appropriate sacred music and supervise outside singers and instrumentalist for weddings.**
- * **Be responsible for making sure music is provided at all parish funerals and is a resource for families, musicians, and celebrant in the selection of music.**

- * **Director of Music/Liturgy will report to and collaborate with the Pastor.**

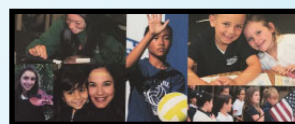
