MAKE THE MOST OUT OF SUNDAY MASS / APROVECHA AL MAXIMO LA MISA

- ◇ Proper attire should be worn at all times when in Church; no shorts, halter tops, tank tops or midriff, baseball caps, torn jeans, flip flops, sunglasses, or other inappropriate attire.
- ◇ Come on time to Mass.
- ◇ Remember to turn off or silence all electronic devices (cell phone, ipad) before entering the church.
- ◇ Please refrain from bringing gum, food, and drinks into the church.
- ◇ Spend time in prayer or meditation, while waiting for Mass to begin.
- ◇ Invite the Holy Spirit to prepare you for the Liturgy.
- ◇ Those who receive Holy Communion should be prepared to receive so great a gift. They should fast (except for medicines) for at least one hour before receiving the Eucharist and should not be conscious of having committed serious sin.
- ◇ All who are not receiving Holy Communion are encouraged to express in their hearts a prayerful desire for unity with the Lord Jesus and with one another.
- ◇ After Holy Communion we may spend some time in silent prayer and/or sing a song of praise.
- ◇ Vestidura apropiada debe de ser usada por todos. No se permiten shorts, camisetas escotadas o sin mangas, gorras, pantalones de mezclilla rotos, chanclas u otra vestidura inapropiada.
- ◇ Vengan puntualmente a Misa.
- ◇ Recuerde apagar o poner en silencio todos los dispositivos electrónicos (celular, ipad) antes de ingresar a la iglesia.
- ◇ Por favor absténgase de traer chicles, comida, bebidas a la iglesia.
- ◇ Dedique tiempo antes para orar o meditar antes de que comience la Misa.
- ◇ Invita al Espíritu Santo a prepararte para la Liturgia.
- ◇ Quienes reciben la Sagrada Comunión deben estar preparados para recibir tan gran regalo. Deben ayunar (excepto los medicamentos) durante al menos una hora antes de recibir la Eucaristía y no deben tener conciencia de haber cometido pecado grave.
- ◇ Todos los que no reciben la Sagrada Comunión a expresar en sus corazones un deseo de oración de unidad con el Señor Jesús y unos con otros.
- ◇ Después de la comunión se puede guardar unos momentos de silencio o cantar un salmo o cantico de alabanza.
