



**STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION/
REFLEXIONES DEL ESPIRITU DE SERVICIO**

4th Sunday in Ordinary Time: February 1

That others can see we live as Christians
by the way we act, dress, and talk.

*“Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is
the kingdom of heaven.” Matthew 5:3*

The phrase “poor in spirit” can be confusing. Think of it in this sense – poor in spirit means depending on God’s providence and not depending on our own self-reliance. Being detached from earthly things (power, money, and comfort) and being attached to heavenly things (charity, sacrifice, and mercy). Denying ourselves from satisfying our desires and helping others obtain their basic needs.

Desprendernos de las cosas terrenales (poder, dinero, y comodidad) y apegarnos a las cosas celestiales (caridad, sacrificio y misericordia). Negarnos a nosotros mismos la satisfacción de nuestros deseos y ayudar a otros a cubrir sus necesidades básicas.

Chúa Nhật IV Thường Niên: 1 tháng Hai

Qua cách chúng ta hành động, ăn mặc và nói năng, người
ta có thể thấy chúng ta thực sự là Kitô Hữu.

*“Phúc cho ai có tinh thần nghèo khó,
vì nước trời là của họ.” Matthêu 5:3*

Câu “tinh thần nghèo khó” có thể hiểu mơ hồ. Hãy nghĩ câu ấy theo nghĩa này – tinh thần nghèo khó có nghĩa tùy thuộc vào sự quan phòng của Thiên Chúa và không tùy thuộc vào sự tự lực của bản thân. 
Feast of the Presentation of the Lord (Candlemas Day)

Monday, February 2nd we celebrate the Feast of the Presentation

of our Lord in the Temple at Jerusalem. Ancient Jewish law required that, following the birth of a firstborn male child, the mother must come to the temple after 40 days for purification and for presentation of the child to the Lord. The presentation of Mary's child, however, was different from most. This was the Christ Child, Jesus, the Savior, the Messiah who had been promised; and he was recognized as such by the elderly Anna and Simeon, who knew that this child was "a light for revelation to all nations." Thus the image of light carries an important part in the liturgy and links itself with the Christmas season and lights of the Advent wreath, the decorative tree lights, and the many candles of the Nativity celebration. To mark this particular feast, the ancient tradition calls for the blessing of candles to be used during the year. From the earliest times this day has been known as Candlemas Day (the Candle Mass). **The Blessing of Candles will take place at the 8:15 am Mass on Monday, February 2. You are invited to bring candles from home.**

Blessing of Throats

Tuesday, February 3rd we celebrate the feast of Saint Blaise, who was bishop of Sebaste in Armenia in the fourth century. Before being martyred, he is said to have healed a boy who was choking. Since the eighth century, Saint Blaise has been venerated as the patron of those who suffer from diseases of the throat. We pray in a special way for protection from afflictions of the throat and from other illnesses. The blessing of Saint Blaise is a sign of our faith in God's protection and love for us and for the sick. **The Blessing of Throats will take place on Tuesday, February 3 after the 8:15am Mass.**

LENTEN GUIDELINES

Lent begins on **Wednesday, February 18**. Below are the guidelines of Lenten observance for the faithful in the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston. **Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence.**



As outlined on the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops' website (www.usccb.org) on Lenten fasting and abstinence: "fasting is obligatory for all who have completed their 18th year and have not yet reached their 60th year. Fasting allows a person to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may be taken, not to equal one full meal. Abstinence (from meat) is obligatory for all who have reached their 14th year.

La Cuaresma comienza el **miércoles 18 de abril del 2026**. A continuación están las guías de la observancia de la Cuaresma para los fieles en el Arquidiócesis de Galveston-Houston. **El Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo son días de ayuno abstinencia. Los viernes de Cuaresma don días de abstinencia.**

La Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de Estados Unidos describe en la pagina de internet Sobre el ayuno y la abstinencia cuaresmal: "el ayuno es obligatorio para todos los que hayan cumplido 18 años y todavía no hayan cumplido 60 años. El ayuno le permite a una persona comer una comida completa. Se pueden tomar dos comidas mas pequeñas, que no equivalen a una comida completa. Abstinencia (de la carne) es obligatorio para todos los que hayan cumplido 14 años.




