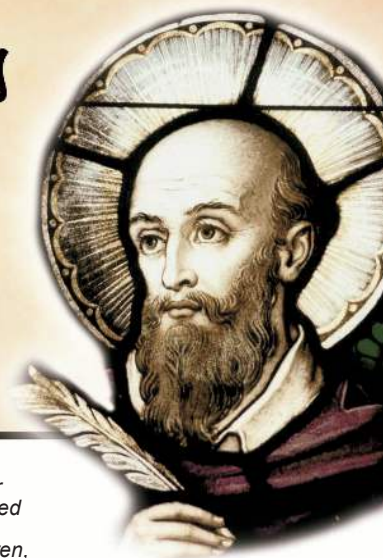

Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord: April 5

That we put God first in everything and not let earthly possessions become gods to us.

“Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth.” Colossians 3:2

Do you put God first in all things? Possessions, money, power, ego can easily become gods to many of us. Do a quick check of what is important to you. Is God at the very top of the list? If not, your priorities need to be readjusted. Don't let earthly things become a god before God. This is also the first commandment – I am the Lord your God, you shall not have any strange gods before me.

Now that hot weather is here, a gentle reminder regarding proper dress for church. Our dress code for God should always be appropriate and modest. It does not always have to be elegant. Casual dress that is modest is acceptable. Beach dress is not. Especially that means no short shorts, no tank tops, and no low-cut tops. Sometimes our young people, influenced by the fashions of society, do not realize that some attire is not appropriate for church. **It is the responsibility of parents to educate them.** Proper dress is evidence of our belief and reverence for our Lord's Presence in the Eucharist and respect for the assembly who gathers with us to pray.
