


Fr. Chris' Corner

What is Eucharistic Adoration?

Understood simply, Eucharistic Adoration is adoring or honoring the Eucharistic Presence of Christ. In a deeper sense, it involves "the contemplation of the Mystery of Christ truly present before us".

During Eucharistic Adoration, we "watch and wait", we remain "silent" in His Presence and open ourselves to His Graces which flow from the Eucharist. By worshiping the Eucharistic Jesus, we become what God wants us to be! Like a magnet, The Lord draws us to Himself and gently transforms us.

Inspire will include Praise & Worship, a short meditation, and Reconciliation will be available. There will also be a social for the students afterward, and we would like to invite you and your family to join us for the social on the first Friday of each month. Faith Formation



As part of the Diocese of Gary's commitment for creating a safe environment for all parishes and schools, a new background check process has been implemented through a new vendor, Selection.com.

All staff and volunteers, ages 18 and over, whom are in contact with minors (those under 18), and have a VIRTUS account, must submit a new background check application by visiting www.virtusonline.org.

Here at St. Teresa's, this would include:

- ◇ staff
- ◇ chaperones
- ◇ catechists (GIFT/CLOW), catechist aides, babysitters,
- ◇ Café Manna heads
- ◇ youth ministers
- ◇ altar server trainers
- ◇ VBS/GIFT Hall Monitors.

If a new staff member or volunteer has not been VIRTUS trained, please visit www.dcgary.org to pre-register for an upcoming VIRTUS class. After pre-registering, you will be able to submit a background check application through Selection.com. (Locally, there is an upcoming session scheduled for 9/27/17 from 6:30pm-9:30pm at St. Patrick's in Chesterton.)
