

Fr. Chris' Corner



Dear friends in the Lord,

Throughout the month of June, we have been celebrating First Communion and it is such a joy to be able to experience this sacred moment with our students. This weekend is particularly fitting because we celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi, the Body and Blood of

Jesus Christ. We remember how God provided for the Israelites in the desert by giving them Manna and how this foreshadowed the Eucharist that Jesus would give us at the Last Supper.

Besides physical hunger, all of us experience another hunger that cannot be satisfied with ordinary food. This is a hunger for life, a hunger for love, a hunger for eternity. The Manna in the desert was the symbol of a food that satisfies that deep human hunger. Jesus, then, gives us this food by giving Himself as the living bread that gives life to the world. His Body is true food in the form of bread; his Blood is the true drink in the form of wine. It isn't simple nourishment to satisfy the body, like Manna; the Body of Christ is the bread capable of giving eternal life.

The Eucharist communicates the Lord's love for us: a love so great that it nourishes us with Himself. This is a freely given love, always available to every person who hungers and needs to regenerate their own strength. What a tremendous gift it is to receive this life spiritually even when we are unable to receive the host physically. To live the experience of faith means to allow oneself to be nourished by the Lord and to build one's own existence, not with material goods, but with the gifts of God in His Word and in His Body. Let us always remember the great gift God has given us in the Eucharist.



This week our tithing will be donated to **FOCUS in honor of Paige Krohn.**





- The St. Teresa of Avila member must notify our Pastoral Associate, Kris Conrad (kristin.conrad@valpo.edu) and provide the following information: name and date of death of loved one, address to send condolence cards, link to funeral home for arrangements (if applicable).
- Funeral arrangements will be provided via link in weekly email.
- **Of course, in the event of the death of a St. Teresa of Avila community member, our community will be notified ASAP.**

Recently deceased loved ones will also be added to Weekly Intercessions and a Mass Intention will be scheduled on behalf of the community of St. Teresa of Avila.


Hilltop Food Drive Update:

The church will be open from 8:00am until 8:00pm with the exception of when any livestream services are taking place. **Please note, when coming into the church you must follow any CDC guidelines.**


