Fr. Jacob's Corner



Perhaps one of the boldest questions ever posed to Jesus that has been recorded in the Gospels is what the scholar of the law posed to Jesus in the Gospel for this week. "Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?" As the

question was asked, one could imagine the room would have gone quiet, and all gathered would have waited eagerly for a response. Looking to test Jesus, the scholar of the law hoped that Jesus would fall into a trap. Of course, Jesus gives a response which not only explains the Old Covenant, the ways of the Old Testament, but also spells out how it would be fulfilled through Him.

In the story of the Good Samaritan, the listeners of the parable would have been flabbergasted. Samaritans were seen as totally other, and were not a part of the in-crowd. For the Samaritan to be the good guy in the story and the priest and the Levite to be the bad guy would have been a punch in the gut. However, the scholar of the law knows that the tables have been turned. What possibly started as a question to trap Jesus in the answer, the scholar of the law must admit that the Good Samaritan not only did the right thing, but the example of the Good Samaritan should be emulated and practiced.

Over this week, let us examine our hearts to reflect on the people that enter into our lives. Who are the people that we think of as other, and who is in our in-crowd? To guide us, we can remember the words of the Gospel, the way of Jesus and the New Covenant, to treat others with mercy.
