This weekend we celebrate Pentecost, the official end of the Easter Season and the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and the face of the earth. The Second Reading at Mass this weekend tells us: "For in hope we were saved. Now hope that sees is not hope. For who hopes for what one sees? But if we hope for what we do not see, we wait with endurance."

2024 FAITH & CHARITY CATHOLIC APPEAL


