This weekend we celebrate the Feast of the Ascension. This feast commemorates Jesus' ascension into Heaven. Historically, this feast has been celebrated 40 days after Easter Sunday - the Thursday in the sixth week of Easter. However, here in our Diocese of Wilmington, we transfer it to the following Sunday. By His death and resurrection, Jesus opened the gates of heaven for all humanity. His Ascension is proof that those of us who believe in Christ in faith and follow Him, will be raised on the last day, and enter heaven. This Feast also celebrates Jesus' promise to send the Holy Spirit and His enthronement in heaven at the Right Hand of the Father.



This weekend we welcome Bishop Malooly, the Bishop Emeritus of our Diocese. Bishop will be here Saturday morning to bestow the Sacrament of Confirmation on nine of our teenagers.
