Dear St. Raphael Parishioners,



Happy Father's Day to all dads! I hope you have an enjoyable day to celebrate with your families.

Corpus Christi Sunday: This Sunday is dedicated to the Eucharist, another central mystery of our faith. Just one week after Trinity Sunday, when we recalled the biggest mystery of all, the Church presents us with another part of the faith that is beyond our full understanding. Just as with the mystery of the Holy Trinity, we make mistakes when we try to reduce it to something we can understand. The Eucharist in particular faces a challenge in our modern pop culture.

We live in a society where materialism is a natural prejudice, a built-in assumption that many people don't even realize they make. There have been a number of opinion polls published over the years that make claims about what percentage of Catholics believe in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. These polls have been the subject of much hand-wringing and expressions of woe in the Catholic media. Personally, I don't take those results too seriously, and I consider the polls themselves part of a larger problem.

Imagine yourself getting a phone call or written survey out of the blue, asking if you are Catholic and about your beliefs on Holy Communion. The pollsters don't ask if you have studied theology, or even how much thought you have given the matter. But they assume that random opinions on this Sacrament are somehow significant. They expect you to take one of the greatest mysteries in human history, and reduce it to checking a box or choosing a pre-worded option over the phone. You might also realize the pollster is not asking out of a genuine interest in the faith, but rather to study you, as an object for their commercial benefit. They have made an audacious and naive assumption that their survey is an appropriate way to study the Eucharist. I wouldn't blame somebody for giving any random answer, just to be rid of the annoying intrusion. We accept the mystery of Eucharist because we accept the supreme authority of Jesus Christ. There is much more we can say about it, enough to fill many books and videos. I encourage you all to keep learning about the Eucharist, and about your faith in general. But don't expect the mysteries to be solved in this lifetime.

June Activities continue: Thank you to all who helped with the picnic last Sunday. Everyone seemed to enjoy themselves and the burgers got rave reviews. Rummage sale drop-offs took place this past week, with the sale starting Wednesday the 22nd. Fr. Jamnicky's celebration follows, next Sunday. We can still use more volunteers for both events, if you haven't already signed up.

Knightly News

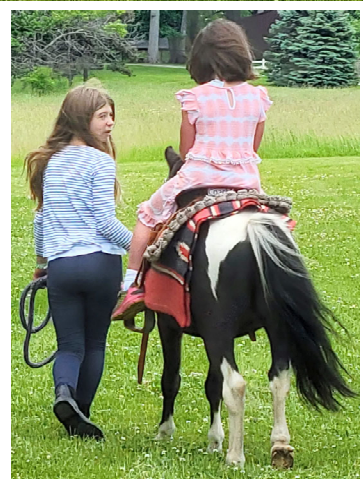

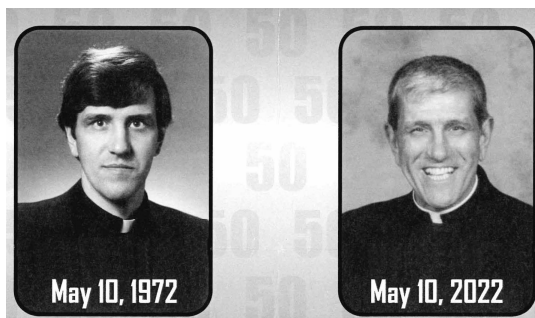

Marriage Preparation: Registered and supporting members should call the office. A date should not be set until consulting the pastor.

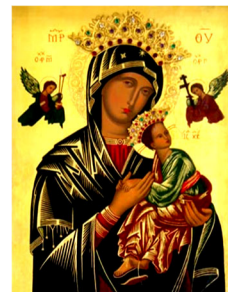

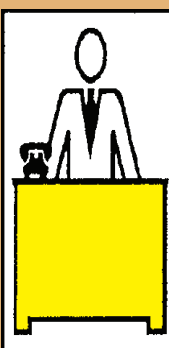
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
