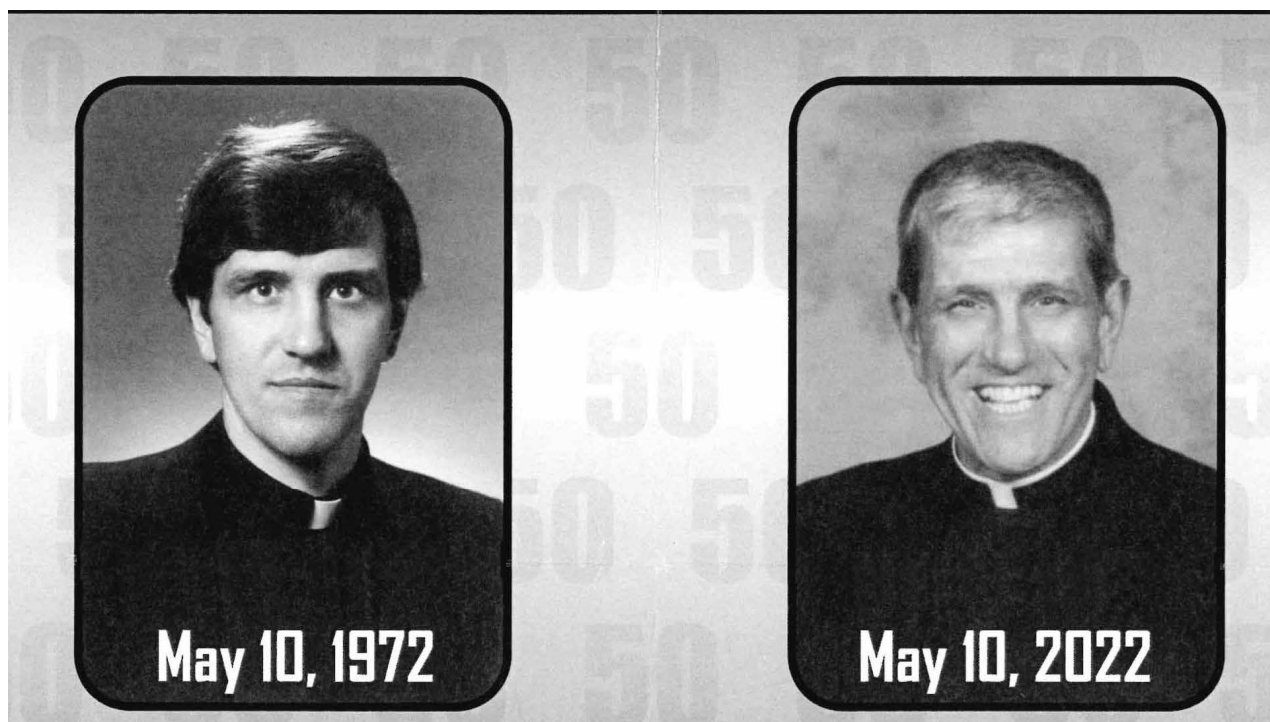

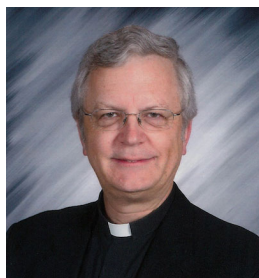

Dear St. Raphael Parishioners,



As we enter into summertime, we are also in the “Ordinary Time” of the Church year. The Mass vestments are green, which mirrors the green of nature around us during the summer. The gospel readings during these weeks feature the parables and miracles of Jesus during his three years of public ministry. I also realize that we have a larger number of people who may be traveling on vacation this summer. Don’t forget to include Sunday Mass in your vacation schedules.

I remember from childhood; my parents were diligent in finding the local Catholic church on Sunday, wherever we went. It was interesting to attend Mass in different parts of the USA on these vacations. I considered it a part of the overall “vacation package”, and it helped me appreciate the diversity and size of our Church.

Welcome to our Founding Pastor: Fr. Jamnicky’s Anniversary Mass on Sunday will be followed by a reception in the outdoor tents. I hope that many of you will be able to join us for this celebration.

This may be a good time to review some of our parish history. For those who have joined St. Raphael in recent years, Fr. John Jamnicky was our founding pastor, and played a big role in the construction of our unique church building. He worked closely with the then Cardinal Archbishop Francis George on the elaborate plan to repurpose parts of older churches in Chicago. So as we welcome him back for this anniversary celebration, it is a chance for him to see how the parish he helped found has grown and thrived. After twelve years, we have reached our largest number of registered households. Although Covid is still keeping our attendance down, numbers are gradually recovering from the low of two years ago. Baptisms have increased over the last year, to probably the highest number in our short history. With our financial picture holding steady, we look toward the coming year with hopes of continued outreach to the souls of northern Lake County.

Rummage Sale Thank-Yous: Gratitude is due to the volunteers who helped with the Sale this past week. It’s too early to report as I’m writing this, but our volunteers have put in a great deal of work to sort and categorize the donations. It’s not likely we will match last year’s numbers, because we had a two-year accumulation of items in 2021. But the sales inventory still looks pretty good this year, and we’re hoping for a successful event.

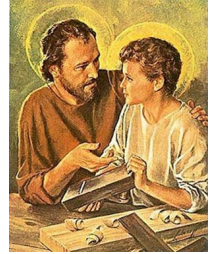

St. Raphael the Archangel Religious Education Program 2022-2023

Early Registration is now being accepted for Religious Education at St. Raphael the Archangel parish for the 2022-2023 academic year for students from Pre-K/K to 8th grade. The Registration forms are available on the parish website at: <https://straphaelcatholic.org/religious-ed-program>



Classes begin on Wednesday, September 7, 2022 at 6:30 pm at Millburn Middle School located at 640 Freedom Way, Lindenhurst, IL 60046.

Parent night meeting will be on August 31, 2022 at 6:30 pm (Fellowship Hall in the church).

Classes end on Wednesday, April 26, 2023.

We have a volunteer to teach PreK/K class for next year. This class would be for students 4-years-old and 5-years-old. Please register your young students if you would like them to start religious education classes in the fall.

Students prepare for the Sacraments of Reconciliation in the 1st grade and 2nd grade.

Students prepare for the Sacrament of Confirmation in the 7th and 8th grade.

Two years of preparation are required prior to receipt of the Sacraments.

Due to the Covid pandemic, the publisher has offered an **eLearning platform** which was used for 3rd to 6th grade this past year. Some parents have requested the flexibility of this option for various reasons.

This option is not available to students preparing for the sacraments in the 1st, 2nd, 7th, & 8th grades.

Program costs: Tuition assessed per family = \$200;

Fees assessed per student are \$50 before June 30th; after June 30th, student fees are \$75 per student.

Early registration helps with planning activities over the summer. Textbooks, materials, class sizes, and volunteer needs are assessed during the summer months to prepare for the start of classes in September. If you are planning to participate in the religious education program next year, please complete the registration paperwork and send it in via email, the post office or dropped off at the Parish Office. There is a lockbox on the office porch for off-hours. If you are considering continuing the eLearning option, please complete the registration paperwork and let me know that this is your intent. Credit card payments may be made via the portal on the parish website at <https://straphaelcatholic.org/give>.

Please indicate that the payment is for religious education as the donation type. Checks may be mailed or dropped off at the parish office with registration forms.

If you have any textbooks from past years, please return the books to the parish office so as to keep costs low and within the program budget.

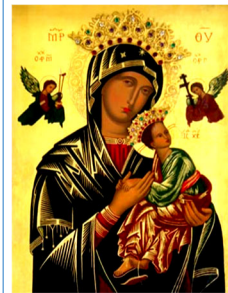

A Concrete Sign of Mercy

The year 2020 united the whole world in suffering as the COVID-19 pandemic took millions of lives and created widespread economic hardship due to the closure of nonessential businesses. In Lebanon, the hardship of the pandemic was compounded by a catastrophic explosion of a warehouse at the port in Beirut on August 4, 2020. The blast killed more than 200 people and injured and displaced thousands more.

With funds collected through the Peter's Pence Collection, the Holy Father provided an immediate response of €250,000 to the Church in Lebanon, which made medical care, temporary shelter, and other basic needs available to victims through the efforts of Caritas Lebanon, Caritas Internationalis, and sister organizations of Caritas. Donations to the Peter's Pence Collection support not only the activities of the Roman Curia that support the pope in the exercise of his ministry but also

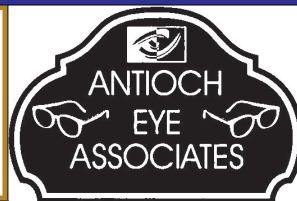

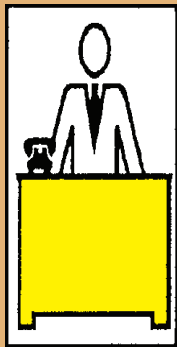
