



Dear St. Raphael Parishioners,



June was truly a month full of activities at St. Raphael Church.

**Anniversary:** A big *thank-you* to all who helped with Fr. Jamnicky's anniversary celebration last Sunday! The weather was perfect and the turnout was wonderful. The Knights of Columbus showed their skill at barbecue, the Altar and Rosary Sodality contributed cakes. We were pleased to welcome a busload of parishioners from St. Celestine in Chicago, where Fr. John had ministered in his "younger days". We were also graced by the presence of our Vicar Bishop Jeff Grob, and Bishop David Malloy of Rockford, along with six concelebrating priests. Fr. Jamnicky gave his customary "just a few announcements" at the end of Mass, as expected. Such a joyful mood of celebration made me feel thankful to be your pastor.

**Rummage Sale Wrap-up:** The Rummage Sale concluded successfully, with final clean-up taking place this past Monday. Total sales were lower than last year's "double inventory", but still healthy. All leftover items are either brought to St. Vincent DePaul Society, or donated to other charities. One local charity sends certain items to missions in Africa that can use them. The rummage sale requires a large amount of volunteer labor, and the first part of the week had some very hot temperatures. I want to express my gratitude to all those who gave of their time or contributed items for sale. At a relatively small parish like ours, the rummage sale income makes a difference in our budget.

**Historic Supreme Court Ruling:** On Friday, June 24, the US Supreme Court issued an important ruling regarding abortion. In a case involving a Mississippi state law, the court ruled that the 1973 *Roe v. Wade* decision was in error and so was overturned. In effect, the 1973 ruling had placed abortion "above the law", meaning governments had almost no authority to regulate it. This new decision rightly points out how *Roe* completely disregarded the arguable right to life of a child in the womb. This resulted in US laws being more anti-life than any country except North Korea. Many legal scholars over the years had made the same point: *Roe* was an irrational and biased decision. And yet this reversal was 49 years in coming, because emotions run so hot on the issue of abortion. The new decision does not make abortion illegal it simply restores authority to the democratic process to make laws about it.

In spite of the sound legal basis for the ruling, you may have seen many expressions of rage in the news, including threats against churches and pro-life aid centers. Most of the Supreme Court Justices are Catholic, so our Church might be a target for this anger. The actions of a few vandals or extremists don't cause me much worry. In two thousand years, our Church has survived far worse than that. In fact, we have faced far more serious challenges from the government within the last decade. But that is a topic for another day.

**Dear Parishioners of St. Raphael,**

As this very busy month of June has come to a close, and the choir is now on break for the summer, I would just like to extend a long overdue "thanks" to all of you for your support and prayers throughout my cancer treatments. For a little over a month now, I have been officially in remission! While I am not yet fully recovered from treatments, which may take a year or more, I am overall doing very well! I have most of my energy back, and once again can do most of the things I haven't been able to do over the past year. I am so fortunate to be part of such a parish community as St. Raphael's. You have all been so patient and understanding, as I struggled to do my best ministry despite the situation.

Over the summer, I hope some of you may consider joining the parish choir in the fall. We will resume regular Sunday singing after Labor Day. We currently have only 8 members, down from a peak of 19 pre-covid. While our current group are all choir veterans, until we improve our numbers, we are simply not able to do the same caliber of music as before. One does not need to read music or have any otherwise formal musical training to join. We have experimented with Sunday rehearsals instead of Wednesday nights, and found it to work out just fine. We may experiment further with a more flexible schedule between 9am and 11am Masses, depending on rehearsal needs. Two-hour rehearsals are necessary in more busy seasons. Not much has happened with the pipe organ project since last summer, for obvious reasons! Sometime in July, we will once again have a volunteer work day. This will involve a lot of heavy lifting and assembly. If you would like to help out, but have not yet taken part in any work days, again, please contact the parish office.



Early Registration is now being accepted for Religious Education at St. Raphael the Archangel parish for the 2022-2023 academic year for students from Pre-K/K to 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Classes begin on Wednesday, September 7, 2022 at 6:30 pm at Millburn Middle School located at 640 Freedom Way, Lindenhurst, IL 60046.

**Parent night** meeting will be on August 31, 2022 at 6:30 pm (Fellowship Hall in the church).

Classes end on Wednesday, April 26, 2023.

**We have a volunteer to teach PreK/K class.** This class would be for students 4-years-old and 5-years-old. Please register your young students if you would like them to start religious education classes in the fall.

Students prepare for the Sacraments of Reconciliation in the 1st grade and 2nd grade.

Students prepare for the Sacrament of Confirmation in the 7th and 8th grade.

Two years of preparation are required prior to receipt of the Sacraments.

Due to the Covid pandemic, the publisher has offered an **eLearning platform** which was used for 3<sup>rd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> grade this past year. Some parents have requested the flexibility of this option for various reasons.

**This option is not available to students preparing for the sacraments in the 1st, 2nd, 7th, & 8th grades.**

Program costs: Tuition assessed per family = \$200;

Fees assessed per student are \$50 before June 30th; after June 30th, student fees are \$75 per student.

Early registration helps with planning activities over the summer. Textbooks, materials, class sizes, and volunteer needs are assessed during the summer months to prepare for the start of classes in September. If you are planning to participate in the religious education program next year, please complete the registration paperwork and send it in via email, the post office or dropped off at the Parish Office. There is a lockbox on the office porch for off-hours. If you are considering continuing the eLearning option, please complete the registration paperwork and let me know that this is your intent. Credit card payments may be made via the portal on the parish website at <https://straphaelcatholic.org/give>.

Please indicate that the payment is for religious education as the donation type. Checks may be mailed or dropped off at the parish office with registration forms.

If you have any textbooks from past years, please return the books to the parish office so as to keep costs low and within the program budget.
