The Paschal Candle has come to symbolize the Risen Christ throughout the Church's liturgy. Whether at Baptisms, Funerals, or at all the Masses of the Easter Season, it stands brightly shining in the sanctuary as a reminder that Christ has conquered the darkness of this world! The light of the Paschal Candle is meant to calm the fears and worries of parents as they bring their children to be baptized and that same light is meant to calm the fears and worries of those children when they come years later to bury their parents.

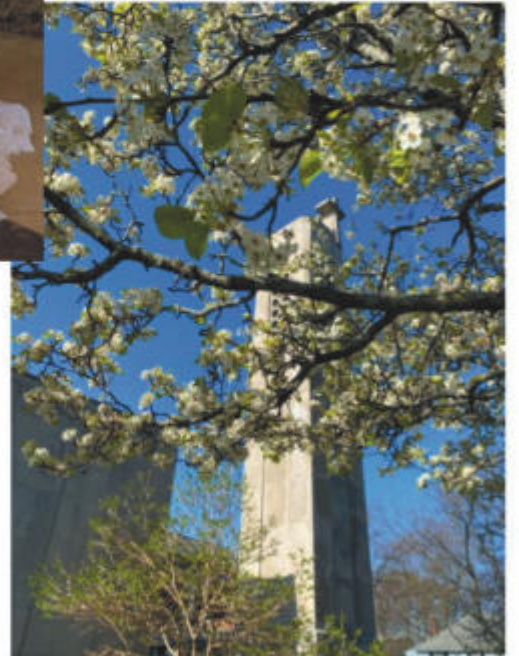
Longing for the day when our Church will be filled again with those who proclaim the Risen Jesus as the Lord of their life!
