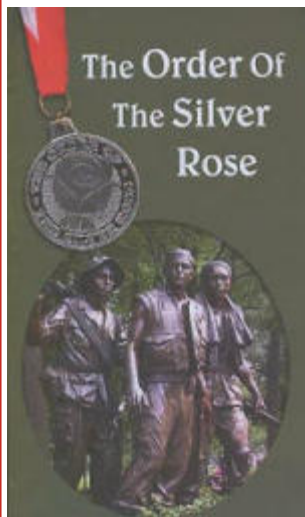

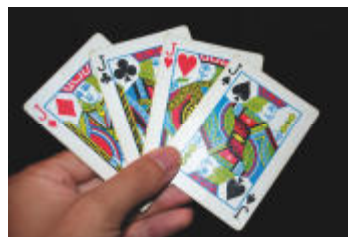
The Silver Rose
