As Christians, we are called to spread the good news. The Great Commission in Matthew 28:19-20 says, "Therefore **go** and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

By encouraging others to go back to church, we are following the directive Jesus gave us. A personal invitation is perhaps the best way to invite someone to church because there's an existing connection for the invitee. Plus, when they visit church because of a personal invitation from someone they know, they already have a point person to answer any questions they may have (and someone to soothe any worries or concerns).
