CATECHISM CORNER

Preparing your Home for Advent

During Advent, Christians prepare for the here-and-now coming of Christ by remembering the long years during which Israel waited for the coming of the Messiah, and by looking forward to the final coming of Christ at the end of time. Here are some practical ways that you can prepare to celebrate Advent with your family.

Have an **Advent wreath.** this is one of the most familiar and beloved symbols of Advent.

Set up a **Nativity scene.** Displaying a nativity scene is a great way to remind everyone about the true meaning of Christmas.

Make a **Jesse tree.** Decorate the tree with ornaments based on symbols of the Old Testament events preparing for the coming of Christ. Examples: an ark and rainbow to depict Noah; a ladder to represent Jacob's ladder.

Keep an **Advent calendar.** This calendar marks off the days of Advent. If you want to observe the spirit of Advent, you can find one on the U.S. Catholic Bishops' website. It also includes activity suggestions for each day.


CYO FOOD DRIVE
