Black History Month



Sister Thea Bowman was born in Yazoo, Mississippi and grew up to be a renowned Roman Catholic nun, teacher and scholar. Born Methodist, she became Catholic when she was nine years old. She became the first African American to join the Franciscan Sisters

of Perpetual Adoration in Wisconsin. After 16 years of teaching, she was invited to be a special consultant for the Catholic church. She gave presentations around the country aimed at bridging racial and cultural divisions. She combined her gifts of singing and gospel preaching, with prayers and storytelling. Sr. Thea was diagnosed with bone cancer in 1984. Yet, she continued her fight against the evils that drive people apart, until her death at age 53 in 1990. Sr. Thea Bowman said she prayed "to live until I die – to live fully." And that she did. A cause for canonization has been opened for Bowman. At the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' 2018 Fall General Assembly, the Committee on Canonical Affairs and Church Governance indicated unanimous support for the advancement of Sister Thea Bowman's canonization cause on the diocesan level.
