



## Some Words from the Pastor

We celebrated the Solemnity of the Ascension last Sunday in which we were reminded of the mission that the Lord had entrusted to his Church. This weekend, we celebrate Pentecost Sunday which is the coming of the Holy Spirit. The Risen Lord who ascended and went back to his Father, had promised his disciples that they will not be left alone. He assured them that the Advocate, the Paraclete, the Holy Spirit will come to empower them in their mission. We remember that during the Last Supper, while speaking to his apostles, Jesus said that after he left this world he would send them the gift of the Father, that is, the Holy Spirit (Jn.15:26). This promise is powerfully fulfilled on the day of Pentecost, when the Holy Spirit descended upon the disciples, who were gathered in the Upper room. This extraordinary outpouring was not limited solely to that moment but was an event that we renewed and still continues to be renewed. It is very interesting to take note of one of the striking messages of Pope Francis as he talks about Pentecost. He said that "a fundamental element of Pentecost is astonishment. Our God is a God of astonishments. He is a God of surprises! No one expected anything more from the disciples: after Jesus' death they were very small, insignificant group of defeated orphans of their master. There occurred instead an unexpected event that astounded them. The people were astonished because each of them heard the disciples speaking in their own tongues, telling of the great works of God. The Pope says further, that the Church born at Pentecost is an astounding community because, with the force of her arrival from God, a new message is proclaimed - the resurrection of Christ - with a new

language, the universal one of love. A new proclamation: Christ lives; he is risen. A new language: the language of love. The disciples are adorned with power from above and speak with courage. Only minutes before, they all were cowardly, but now they speak with courage and candor, with the freedom of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit, who has wholly animated the life and mystery of Jesus, is the same Spirit who today guides Christian existence, the existence of men and women who call themselves Christians and want to be Christians. To subject our Christian life and mission which we have all received in baptism, to the action of the Holy Spirit, means that we find the apostolic courage necessary to overcome easy worldly accommodations. (Excerpts from the book: *The Joy of Discipleship: Reflections from Pope Francis on Walking with Christ*). Let us allow the Holy Spirit to renew and empower us once again to be able to do our mission in the context of our world today. To be a disciple nowadays is more challenging. Thus, we need the Spirit all the more to guide and enlighten us in our journey of faith, as we proclaim the message of the Risen Lord to people that we meet every day. We have to pray and invoke him: Come Holy Spirit. Fill our hearts and enkindle in us the fire of your love. Help us to live as true disciples of Christ.

## Pentecost Sunday

Today's Readings: Acts 2:1-11; Ps 104:1, 24, 29-30, 31, 34; 1 Cor 12:3b-7, 12-13 or Rom 8:8-17; Jn 20:19-23 or Jn 14:15-16, 23b-26

In today's Gospel Luke, the author of Acts, links the "time of Pentecost" to the Jewish Feast of Weeks. This was a harvest festival, fifty days after Passover. The feast became a celebration of God's gift of the Torah, the law of Moses, remembering Exodus 19. Luke suggests that just as the Feast of Weeks was a culmination of Passover, the outpouring of the Holy Spirit was a culmination of the Resurrection. In both Passover and Easter, God's extraordinary saving action rescued God's people from oppression and death. Because of these actions, the stage was set for the gift of Torah, and similarly for Christians, the gift of the Spirit. The ongoing presence of the Spirit sustains us to face life's burdens gracefully. The Spirit also challenges us daily to mature in our capacity to love, and to take part in God's ongoing work to rescue all God's people.

### What God Is Up To

The Christian community gathered in the Upper Room, awaiting the Holy Spirit, has long stirred the Christian imagination. In our own time, when the Church has a long history of Christian faith but now faces many challenges, we might return to this image. Like the first disciples, we often don't know what to do next. What used to work for us doesn't work as well. We need to stay together, honor diversity, reflect upon the roots of our faith, and remain rooted in prayer. Yet there is more. Pentecost has happened and is happening. The Spirit has already burst out into the world, already stirring among those who are confused about God. The Book of Acts tells the story of a Church

continually pushed out by the Spirit, to join in what God was already up to, out in the world. We too are invited not only to remember our unity and our roots, but to pay acute attention to how the Spirit is working in our local communities.

### Variety of Gifts

In today's second reading, Saint Paul wrote to the Church in Corinth, a community encountering tensions and divisions over spiritual gifts. Paul reminds them that the Spirit shares a variety of gifts; none is better than any other, and all are needed by the whole Church. The Spirit is revealed in the diversity of gifts offered by individuals and by distinct groups. The Spirit desires that the Church live as an interdependent, cohesive whole, as the Body of Christ.

A parish can be a collegial partnership where parishioners, clergy, and ministry staff can confidently share God's gifts. Gifts from persons and groups of diverse backgrounds can be honored. Gifts that tend to be less visible, such as in finance, custodial work, or administration, can be celebrated as much as those in preaching and music. May we notice God's grace in this diversity.

## Domingo de Pentecostés

Lecturas de hoy: Hch 2:1-11; Sal 104 (103):1, 24, 29-30, 31, 34; 1 Cor 12:3b-7, 12-13 o Rom 8:8-17; Jn 20:19-23 o Jn 14:15-16, 23b-26

En el Evangelio de hoy, Lucas, el autor de los Hechos, relaciona el "tiempo de Pentecostés" con la fiesta judía de las Semanas. Esta era una fiesta de la cosecha, cincuenta días después de la Pascua. La fiesta se convirtió en una celebración del regalo de Dios de la Torá, la ley de Moisés, recordando Éxodo 19. Lucas sugiere que, al igual que la Fiesta de las Semanas era una culminación de la Pascua, la efusión del Espíritu Santo era una culminación de la Resurrección. Tanto en la Pascua como en la Pascua, la extraordinaria acción salvadora de Dios rescató al pueblo de Dios de la opresión y la muerte. Gracias a estas acciones, se preparó el escenario para el don de la Torá, y de forma similar para los cristianos, el don del Espíritu. La presencia continua del Espíritu nos sostiene para afrontar las cargas de la vida con gracia. El Espíritu también nos desafía cada día a madurar en nuestra capacidad de amar y a participar en la obra continua de Dios para rescatar a todo el pueblo de Dios.

### Lo Que Dios Estás Haciendo

La comunidad cristiana reunida en el Cenáculo, a la espera del Espíritu Santo, ha suscitado durante mucho tiempo la imaginación cristiana. En nuestro tiempo, cuando la Iglesia tiene una larga historia de fe cristiana, pero ahora se enfrenta a muchos desafíos, podríamos volver a esta imagen. Como los primeros discípulos, a menudo no sabemos qué hacer a continuación. Lo que solía funcionar para nosotros ya no funciona tan bien. Tenemos que permanecer juntos, honrar la diversidad, reflexionar sobre las raíces de nuestra fe y permanecer arraigados en la oración. Pero hay más. Pentecostés ha

ocurrido y está ocurriendo. El Espíritu ya ha irrumpido en el mundo, ya se agita entre los que están confundidos sobre Dios. El libro de los Hechos cuenta la historia de una Iglesia continuamente empujada por el Espíritu, para unirse a lo que Dios ya estaba haciendo en el mundo. También nosotros estamos invitados no sólo a recordar nuestra unidad y nuestras raíces, sino a prestar una gran atención a la forma en que el Espíritu está actuando en nuestras comunidades locales.

### Variedad de Dones

En la segunda lectura de hoy, san Pablo escribe a la Iglesia de Corinto, una comunidad que sufre tensiones y divisiones en torno a los dones espirituales. Pablo les recuerda que el Espíritu comparte una variedad de dones; ninguno es mejor que otro, y todos son necesarios para toda la Iglesia. El Espíritu se revela en la diversidad de dones que ofrecen los individuos y los distintos grupos. El Espíritu desea que la Iglesia viva como un todo interdependiente y cohesionado, como el Cuerpo de Cristo. Una parroquia puede ser una asociación colegiada en la que los feligreses, el clero y el personal ministerial pueden compartir con confianza los dones de Dios. Se pueden honrar los dones de personas y grupos de diversos orígenes. Los dones que tienden a ser menos visibles, como los de las finanzas, la custodia o la administración, pueden celebrarse tanto como los de la predicación y la música. Que podamos notar la gracia de Dios en esta diversidad.
