

Some Words from the Pastor

In the Archdiocese of Los Angeles, the past week was characterized by coming and going, as priests transferred from one parish to another for their new assignments. Some parishes have new pastors and likewise, associate pastors. It is a partial reshuffling, unlike what they have in other places, like the Philippines, that every six years, every priest has to move to another assignment. There is a difference here, however. If a priest finishes a term of six years, or twelve if he opted to extend his assignment for another term, he has to move. It may vary for associate pastors. They can be assigned to a parish for three years or less, which is the standard number of years. Before, they can be assigned for five years in a parish, which is rare nowadays.

We had a beautiful celebration of the fellowship gathering and dinner for Fr. Guillermo and Fr. Yesu, for the welcome and despedida, respectively. Many parishioners attended this gathering which was held at the High School grounds, since we do not have a parish hall yet. I wish to thank everyone who put this gathering together. We thank those who gave monetary donations for the food and drinks. We thank those who did the physical arrangement, set up the stage and decorated it, and for the sound system. I thank the members of the Parish Council and Finance Council who worked hard in preparing for this gathering. It was a clear manifestation of the spirit of stewardship as we all shared our time, talents and treasure. May the Lord continue to bless you.

This also reflects our love for God, whom we shall love always. Loving God is loving one another. It is our way to inherit eternal life. A young man in the gospel of Luke was concerned about how to enter eternal life. The Lord told him to keep the law and the commandments, which the man enumerated knowledgeably: You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your being, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself. To justify himself, he asked the Lord who his neighbors are. The whole Gospel narrative leads us to regard each one as our neighbor, even those that we may consider as our enemies. Everyone is our neighbor. We should be able to love our neighbor if we claim that we love God. Otherwise, we are liars, as John in his letter would say. How do we treat each one? What have we done for them? The Lord will ultimately say to us at the solemn judgment at the end of time, " Whatever you did to the least of my brothers and sisters, you did it to me(Mt. 25:40).

Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today's Readings: Dt 30:10–14; Ps 69:14, 17, 30–31, 33–34, 36, 37 or Ps 19:8, 9, 10, 11; Col 1:15–20; Lk 10:25–37

Love God. Love neighbor. This is our call, the sum of all it means to live as Christ's holy people in the world. Moses told the people that the law—all that sums up this call to love God and neighbor—isn't far off, something distant and hard to reach. It is in our hearts and minds, on our lips. We have only to live what has been instilled in us through the grace of God and the power of the Holy Spirit, the fullness of God's love that dwells in us through Christ. We who are baptized into Christ's life rely on this presence as we extend ourselves in service as did the Samaritan who saw the need of the injured traveler and stopped everything to give comfort, care, and mercy. Such love of neighbor is an outpouring and sign of the love of Christ.

Love God

What does it mean to love God with all our heart, being, strength, and mind? We turn our hearts to God in prayer, quiet moments of reflection, and participation in the Mass and sacraments. Our whole being may turn to the Lord in trust in the midst of troubled times or when we need courage. We find strength to live as Christ's people, even when faced with the questions, doubts, and derision of others. We may turn to the Lord with our mind as we prayerfully read sacred scripture and learn more fully the teaching of the Church. All of these things point to a singular desire to know God deeply. The love we have for God is, after all, a reflection of the great love God has for each of us.

Did you Know?

Check your smoke alarms

The National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) recommends that smoke alarms be installed on every level of the home, inside every bedroom, and outside every sleeping area. Keep alarms away from drafts caused by fans or air ducts, as this could blow smoke away from the sensor. The NFPA also recommends that you test your alarms at least once a month, and replace the batteries every six months, or as soon as a low battery chirp is heard. Love Neighbor

Jesus' parable of the Good Samaritan points to the impact our love of God is to have in our lives. The priest and Levite were more concerned with observing the letter of the law rather than living its essence. The Samaritan found himself unable to pass by without coming to the traveler's aid. Who are the travelers whom we meet? What is our response? Are we so filled with the love of God that we cannot ignore the suffering of hunger or homelessness, the needs of the lonely and sick? Loving God necessitates loving our neighbor. We cannot have one without the other. Jesus shows us that the love we are to share is selfless, sacrificial. The Samaritan not only cared for the traveler's wounds, but took him to find shelter and paid for his care. He went the extra mile on the journey of faith. Who is your neighbor today? How will you love him or her?

Amar a Dios. Amar al prójimo. Esta es nuestra llamada, la suma de todo lo que significa vivir como el pueblo santo de Cristo en el mundo. Moisés dijo al pueblo que la ley —todo lo que resume esta llamada a amar a Dios y al prójimo— no está lejos, algo distante y difícil de alcanzar. Está en nuestros corazones y mentes, en nuestros labios. Sólo tenemos que vivir lo que se nos ha inculcado por la gracia de Dios y el poder del Espíritu Santo, la plenitud del amor de Dios que habita en nosotros por medio de Cristo. Los que estamos bautizados en la vida de Cristo contamos con esta presencia cuando nos extendemos en el servicio como lo hizo el samaritano que vio la necesidad del viajero herido y dejó de hacer todo para dar consuelo, cuidado y misericordia. Ese amor al prójimo es una efusión y un signo del amor de Cristo.

Amar a Dios

¿Qué significa amar a Dios con todo nuestro corazón, ser, fuerza y mente? Dirigimos nuestro corazón a Dios en la oración, en los momentos de reflexión y en la participación en la misa y los sacramentos. Todo nuestro ser puede dirigirse al Señor con confianza en medio de los tiempos difíciles o cuando necesitamos valor. Encontramos fuerza para vivir como pueblo de Cristo, incluso cuando nos enfrentamos a las preguntas, dudas y burlas de los demás. Podemos dirigirnos al Señor con nuestra mente mientras leemos en oración la Sagrada Escritura y aprendemos más plenamente la enseñanza de la Iglesia. Todas estas cosas apuntan a un deseo singular de conocer profundamente a Dios. El amor que tenemos por Dios es, después de todo, un reflejo del gran amor que Dios tiene por cada uno de nosotros.

Amor al Prójimo

La parábola de Jesús sobre el buen samaritano señala el impacto que debe tener nuestro amor a Dios en nuestras vidas. El sacerdote y el levita estaban más preocupados por cumplir la letra de la ley que por vivir su esencia. El samaritano se vio incapaz de pasar de largo sin acudir en ayuda del viajero. ¿Quiénes son los viajeros que encontramos? ¿Cuál es nuestra respuesta? ¿Estamos tan llenos del amor de Dios que no podemos ignorar el sufrimiento del hambriento o de los sintecho o que viven en las calles, las necesidades del solitario y del enfermo? Amar a Dios exige amar al prójimo. No podemos tener uno sin el otro. Jesús nos muestra que el amor que debemos compartir es desinteresado, sacrificado. El samaritano no sólo atendió las heridas del viajero, sino que lo llevó a buscar refugio y pagó por sus cuidados. Hizo un esfuerzo adicional en el camino de la fe. ¿Quién es tu prójimo hoy? ¿Cómo le vas a amar?

¿Sabía Usted?

Revise sus detectores de humo

La Asociación Nacional de Protección contra Incendios (NFPA, por sus siglas en inglés) recomienda que se instalen detectores de humo en todos los niveles de la casa, dentro de cada dormitorio y fuera de cada área para dormir. Mantenga las alarmas alejadas de corrientes de aire provocadas por ventiladores o conductos de aire, ya que esto podría alejar el humo del sensor. La NFPA también recomienda que pruebe sus alarmas al menos una vez al mes y reemplace las baterías cada seis meses, o tan pronto como escuche un sonido de batería baja.
