#### **POOR BOX**



#### New Roof!

In collaboration with the Archdiocese of Washington, architect Larry Abell, and the Manor House Technical Committee, Fr. Pineda has



signed a contract with RRH Associates LLC of Huntingtown, MD for a replacement of the Manor House roof. After looking at options, a decision was made to use a slate gray, coated steel standing seam product. The Manor House has had a metal roof in the past. Fascia and soffits will be repaired, and the technical committee is looking to replace the dormer windows at the same time. Work should start this month, with projected completion in May 2021.

### A NOTE FROM YOUR SHEPHERD

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ, Pax et Bonum!

We are now entering the holiest week in our Church calendar. When we started our Lenten journey on Ash Wednesday, we prepared ourselves with the traditional Lenten practices of fasting and abstinence, almsgiving, and prayer. We also examined our conscience and (hopefully) we availed of the sacrament of reconciliation. Now, Holy Week has commenced.

We begin Holy Week with Palm Sunday. Also called Passion Sunday, we focus on our Lord's triumphant entry into Jerusalem, but we also look at our Lord's days of suffering and death. Thursday marks the beginning of the Paschal Triduum. The Paschal Triduum (TRID-oo-um), which is the Latin word for three days, commemorates the redemptive journey of Christ through death, burial, and resurrection to new life. The Church observes the Triduum as a single event made up of three distinct parts.

Holy Thursday is also called Maundy Thursday because of Jesus' new *mandatum*, which means commandment in English. This is the night when our Lord gave the commandment to love another and when he washed his disciples' feet. After communion, we will process to the altar of the repose where we will have the opportunity to adore the Lord until midnight.

Good Friday is the only day when the Church does not celebrate Mass. We will mark the events of our Lord's trial, crucifixion, death, and burial with special observances. We will pray the Stations of the Cross at 3pm and celebrate the Passion liturgy at 7pm. Because of Covid restrictions, our veneration of the cross will be limited to adoration and genuflection instead of the traditional kissing of the cross. However, rosary rings with a wooden cross will be available for you to take home so you can continue the veneration of the cross in your homes.

The Easter vigil will be celebrated on Holy Saturday, after sundown. During the Easter vigil, we will have three baptized adult Christians who will be received into the Church and one adult Catholic who will be confirmed. For those who cannot make it to the Easter vigil, we will have three Masses on Easter Sunday: 6:30am (Sunrise service), 8am, and 11am.

May we continue to use this time to meditate on what our Lord Jesus Christ did to redeem us.
