

ANNIVERSARY MASS




"FEED MY SHEEP"

AN ACT OF SPIRITUAL COMMUNION


My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love you above all things, and I desire to receive you into my soul.

A NOTE FROM YOUR SHEPHERD

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ, Pax et Bonum!

When I was a kid, one of the things I remember the most during the Solemnity of Corpus Christi was the procession of the Blessed Sacrament. There is just something special when people walk behind the Blessed Sacrament. When I moved to Los Angeles in 2000, I believe that we did it at my parish and when I moved to Hyattsville in 2008, I was glad that our parish had that tradition, too.

The procession of the Blessed Sacrament is just one of the many traditions of honoring our Lord Jesus Christ. After all, our Lord is truly, really, and substantially present in the appearance of bread and wine. Our fitting term for the change that happens during Mass is *transubstantiation*. When the priest prays the Eucharistic Prayer, invokes the Holy Spirit, and says the Institution Narrative, "This is my body...this is the chalice of my blood...Do this in memory of me...," the substance of bread and wine is changed to the Body and Blood of our Lord.

Why believe in this? Because our Lord Jesus Christ says so. This is the heart of our faith. Out of love for each one of us, he humbly gives himself for us in the appearance of bread and wine so He can be with us.

Hence, as we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood our Lord Jesus Christ, let us remember that the Eucharist is the "source and summit of the Christian life" (Lumen Gentium, 11). The Eucharist is freely given to us by God. The least we can do is be thankful and receive our Lord worthily. It is true that nobody is deserving of the Eucharist because no matter what we do, we can never equate what God has done for us. This is the reason why we abstain from receiving the Eucharist if we are in a state of mortal sin. This is a good reminder for us to go to confession (another sacrament that is freely available to us) to clean our soul and prepare our hearts before receiving the Eucharist.

As we celebrate Corpus Christi, let us reflect on the words from St. Thomas Aquinas's *Tantum Ergo*:

Down in adoration falling,
Lo! the sacred Host we hail;
Lo! o'er ancient forms departing,
Newer rites of grace prevail;
Faith for all defects supplying,
Where the feeble senses fail.
