
Rock 'n Roll with Nancy

FUNDRAISER HELPS OUR FAITH FORMATION PROGRAM

What is Accepted:

- Bottles and CANS that are clearly marked as eligible for Return Deposit in MA (such as many brands of beer, wine coolers, and soda)
- All donations must be rinsed and bagged as fully sorted as possible. For instance, one bag per brand of beer bottles; another bag of soda cans that are all Coke products (ie, Coke, Sprite, Barg's Root Beer).

What is NOT Accepted:

- Bottles and CANS that are NOT eligible for Return Deposit in MA (such as hard cider, coffee drinks, juice, lemonade, iced tea, milk drinks, sports drinks, and water). Please check each item to be sure it is marked for Return Deposit for MA. If the label has been damaged or removed, we can not accept it.
- Dirty or sticky bottles and cans. Anything you bring will need to be checked and handled by our student volunteers. Please be considerate of them and everyone else who will need to handle your donated bottles and cans.

How it Helps:

Your returnables will be turned into cash for St. Denis Parish!

Why Pre-Sorting is SO IMPORTANT!

Due to the pandemic, and the recycling center's requirements, we are being asked to supply everything sorted as described in the link below. Any amount of pre-sorting you can do ahead of time will help protect our students, as items will need to be handled less. If you are unable to presort, we will still accept your donations.

How to Sort Your Returnables:

FIRST BY TYPE AND SIZE...

- Please sort all like items together. For instance, keep all glass bottles separate from all aluminum cans or plastic bottles.
- Do not mix sizes of plastic bottles please keep all 2 liter bottles separate from 1 liter bottles. All other plastic bottle sizes (24, 16 or 12 oz) can be sorted together.

...THEN, BAG EACH TYPE/SIZE BAG BY BRAND

After sorting by type and size, then bag by brand and/or supplier. A


