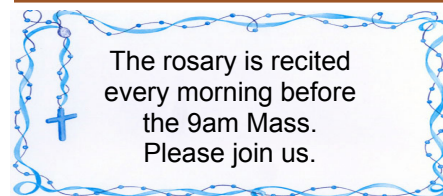

A Note from Our Pastor,

Thank you in advance for your generosity to our 2nd Collection this weekend to support the relief efforts for those who suffered the ravages of Hurricane Dorian.

Many thanks for your generosity to last weekend's second collection for the retirement and healthcare needs of us priests here in the Archdiocese of Boston.

Last Sunday we had a wonderful turnout of catechists for Grades 1-6 for their opening breakfast in our Faith Formation Program, and new catechist training took place during this past week. This week begins Faith Formation for Grades 1-6 on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday! All sessions this week will begin at 4:00pm in the Upper Church for a brief prayer service before students and teachers will make their way to the school building.

This Sunday there will be a meeting for parents of students in the 2nd year of the Confirmation Program at 3:30pm in the Gathering Space, and classes for Year 2 will begin at 6pm.

Students in 6th, 7th, and 8th grades in our Faith Formation EDGE Program will have their first meeting with Helen Bornhorst this Thursday the 26th from 6:30 to 8pm in the Gathering Space.

Our new Bereavement Group will meet again this Wednesday September 25th from 6:30 to 7:45 pm in the Rectory Conference Room.

As many of you are well aware, St. Agatha Parish is a supporter of Nuestros Pequeños Hermanos (NPH—"Our dear little brothers and sisters" aka "Irish Hearts for Orphans"). Victor de los Santos, a young man who has been assisted by NPH in his academic career, will be speaking at our Masses next weekend, and there will be a second collection taken up to help support the ongoing mission of NPH.

For future planning:

Please note that our High School Youth Group Kick-off will take place next Sunday the 29th from 6 to 8pm in the Gathering Space. I'm sure our Youth Minister Helen Bornhorst and her team will have all sorts of fun and inspiring events planned for that evening.

We'll begin again another wonderful year of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) a week from Monday September 30th. Anyone interested in learning a bit more about our Catholic faith, or thinking about becoming Catholic, or being confirmed as an adult if already baptized is invited to the Gathering Space at 7pm on the 30th. I am very grateful to two of our most recent new Catholics who went through the program last year, Scott Johnson and Amalia Halpin, for speaking about their experience at Masses here this month.

On Wednesday October 9th from 7 to 8pm in the Chapel we'll have a Parish Holy Hour with Adoration of the Exposed Blessed Sacrament, music, time for quiet prayer, and Benediction, followed by refreshments.

Our next Mass of Anointing will take place on Saturday October 19th at 11am in the Chapel followed by lunch. We are asking those who plan to participate and stay for lunch to contact the parish secretary no later than Tuesday October 15th so that we can plan on the luncheon numbers.

A night of spiritual enrichment and training/updating for current and new liturgical ministers will take place in the Church on Wednesday October 29th from 7 to 8:30pm. Father William Murphy, a professor and spiritual director at Pope St. John XXIII National Seminary, will give a keynote presentation on the Mass and will also lead the session for Lectors. This evening is for current and new Lectors, Eucharistic Ministers, Homebound Ministers, and Adult Altar Servers.

September 22 ~ Twenty-fifth Sunday of Ordinary Time

THE WEEKLY UPDATE

The Masonry project on the Church is moving along very well. The contractor now expects to have completed the majority of the work by the end of this month so the protective netting around the Church tower and the scaffolding beneath it can be removed. Within the next several weeks we'll put a few pictures in the Bulletin showing the areas of severe deterioration that they found and corrected. This critically necessary project will be a tremendous investment in the long-term integrity of the Church's physical structure. And as mentioned in previous Operations Notes, this will also provide us with the opportunity to do the internal repairs that water seepage has caused to walls and ceilings over the years. But don't worry—the money for those repairs is already included in the parish's operating budget! Speaking of the budget, it's the time of year to prepare the parish and school Annual Reports. We're putting everything together now and expect to have the final report on Fiscal Year 2019 income and expenses and the approved Fiscal Year 2020 budget for the current fiscal year ready for Finance Council review shortly. As in past years, the report will be presented as an insert into the Weekly Bulletin and this should occur on the second weekend in October.

In addition to the Offertory total below, an additional \$7,347 was contributed to the second collection for the health & retirement needs of our priests. Thanks so much for your generosity.

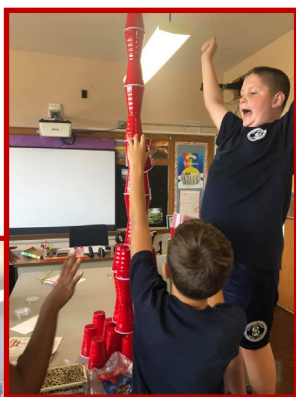

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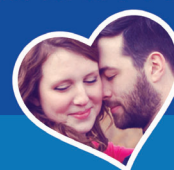
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
