A Note from Our Pastor,

Thank you for your support of the Clergy Health and Retirement Trust collection last weekend. This Tuesday evening September 29th at 7pm there will be the annual Archdiocesan Celebration of the Priesthood Gala, but it won't be a dinner. It will be a virtual online event. The keynote speaker will be General Joe Dunford, Jr., retired and former Head of the Joint Chiefs of Staff. Also speaking will be Mark Wahlberg, a well-known actor who grew up in Dorchester; South Shore native and NHL hockey player Brian Boyle; and our Archbishop Seán Cardinal O'Malley. Registration is free, and accessed at clergytrust.org/celebration. It should be an interesting and informative evening. So, please tune in online if you are able!

Our co-ordinators for this Year of the Eucharist Kathleen and Peter Powers called a meeting of our Parish's Adult Faith Formation and Spiritual Life Committee recently to discuss and plan for events to deepen our love and appreciation for the Holy Eucharist. Since the COVID-19 outbreak we have suspended Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, but I am happy to announce that beginning this coming Friday October 2nd, in the Upper Church each Friday we will have Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament immediately following the 9am Mass. On Fridays funerals will not begin until 11am, and when there is a Friday funeral Adoration will conclude after one hour—at 10:30am. However, on those Fridays where there are no funerals Adoration will continue until Noon. Please spread the word!

As I mentioned last week, we invite any adults interested in learning more about our Catholic Christian faith and seeking full initiation into the Catholic Church, or who are already Catholic but have not received the Sacraments of Eucharist or Confirmation, to come and check out our RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) Program. If you are considering becoming Catholic or growing in your Catholic faith, or know others who might be interested, please send an email to RCIA@stagathaparish.org, and a member of our RCIA team will be in contact with you.

Because of the large number of students in St. Agatha School this year and the COVID restrictions, so evident in the roped-off pews in our Church, we have scheduled FOUR Opening of School Masses. We had 2 of them this past week, and will have 2 more this week: on Wednesday and Thursday September 30 and October 1 at 1pm. Because of the space restrictions, the Masses

are limited to the teachers, students, and staff of St. Agatha School. For parents and other relatives and friends who would like to tune in, however, Deacon Dan Sullivan will be livestreaming the Masses and making them available on our Vimeo link on the St. Agatha Parish website.

All high school students are invited to HOLY SMOKES from 7 to 8pm on Monday nights, including this Monday the 28th, where you come together with our Youth Minister Helen Waring at the patio behind the chapel (accessed through the Gathering Space) to enjoy the warmth of the Lord and one another for a bonfire and prayer!

Adoration is Returning to St. Agatha Parish

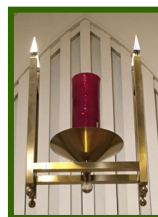

THE WEEKLY UPDATE

I was mulling over what to include in another thrilling Operations Note when I received word that Jean Mara, a long time parishioner and teacher at St. Agatha School had passed away. So my previous thoughts for a Note went out the window and this one is a tribute to a terrific person. Jean Mara was one of those people who is very hard to describe in a few short sentences. She was most definitely "larger than life" and when you entered a room you knew Jean was there. She was a fun-loving, jovial person who loved people, loved a good laugh, and had a wink and a smile for everyone she met. Encountering Jean would brighten anyone's day. For example, the highlight of the Staff Christmas party was always Jean making an appearance wearing an outrageous flashing hat or vest! She began her teaching career at St. Agatha School in 1975 and taught for 40 years until she retired in 2015. During that time she had a profound impact on the lives of hundreds and hundreds of children, including two of my own who even now remember her as the best teacher they ever had. But as incredible as her teaching career was, it doesn't even begin to capture the impact Jean had on others. For decades she was a fixture almost daily at My Brother's Keeper during the Christmas season. She also volunteered each Summer at Camp Fatima in New Hampshire, and was a vital member of the RCIA program here at St. Agatha parish. In short, when Jean saw a need her first thought was about how she could help. Her infectious spirit, her profound Faith and her indomitable will during her battle with cancer in recent years offer testimony to a person whose life truly made a difference. May she rest in the Lord's peace.

Permanent Diaconate Inquirers Program: Is Christ Calling You?

God is calling each of us to serve one another in charity and love and Pope Francis speaks to this call constantly. For some there is a particular invitation to serve Christ and the Church in ordained ministry. The Permanent Diaconate, restored at Vatican II, is a ministry of service that is open to married and single men. The deacon's ministry, in the words of Blessed Pope John Paul II, "is the Church's service sacramentalized."

Deacons are ordained to the Ministry of Service in three areas: Word, Sacrament, and Charity. As a servant to the Word, deacons proclaim the gospel, instruct the faithful, and evangelize by word and deed, as did the great deacons Saint Stephen and Saint Francis. As a servant of the sacramental life of the church, deacons preside at baptisms, assist at the Eucharist, bring the Eucharist to the sick and suffering, witness marriages, bury the dead, and preside at Benediction. As a servant of charity, like the great deacon Saint Lawrence, deacons report the needs of the community to the Church and bring its support and assistance to those in need. The deacon is called to be the "Icon of Christ the Servant" living out the life of charity for the people of God and being an "animator" for all to feed the hungry, visit the sick, and care for one another in our brokenness.

Because deacons work in the secular world and most are married men with families, they share in the worries and stresses of daily life. Permanent deacons know well the difficulties of balancing faith, family, and financial security. Through the deacon living in the world as an ordained minister, the Church knows personally the challenges, demands, fears, and anxieties of the People of God. By his vocation the deacon bridges work, family, and leisure with the life of the Church. In fact, by living and working in the secular world, the deacon seeks to model, in his person, the integration of what one believes and how one lives.

If you are discerning God's possible call to serve the Church as a minister of Charity, Word, and Sacrament as an ordained deacon in the Archdiocese of Boston, you and your wife are invited to take part in the upcoming **Online Inquirer Webinar Program**. First possible session begins on September 29.

Those who are interested in the Diaconate are strongly encouraged to participate in all three online webinar sessions. To register for the Webinar series please visit www.bostondiaconate.org. Questions concerning the inquiry program can be directed to Deacon Christopher Connelly, Director for the Permanent Diaconate by email, cconnelly@rcab.org.

We ask anyone in attendance at Sunday Masses to fill out an online form so that we can have accurate contact information in case the need to contact attendees arises. You only need to fill out the form and leave your information one time.

If we were to discover that someone at any given Mass tests positive for COVID-19 in the following weeks, we want to be able to inform all of you so that, in consultation with your physician, you can take the appropriate steps. Please note that any notice will not include the name of the person who tested positive, which will be kept confidential, but only the Mass (date and time) which they attended and any other relevant non-personal information.

Even if you do not choose to leave your name and contact information, please know that we will make any announcement of a positive test on the parish website as well, so please check the website on a regular basis. 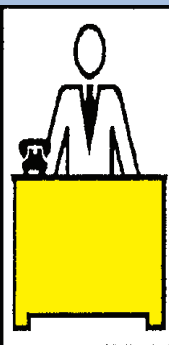

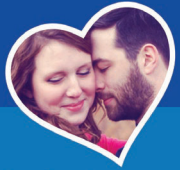
