



A Note from Our Pastor,

It has been wonderful the past couple of weeks to see more of our parishioners returning to Sunday Mass, and I am very grateful to note the increase in the weekly offertory collection. Thank you for taking part in our weekly celebration of the Eucharist. The one Mass where we still await more people to participate is the 9:30am Family Mass. A number of our young cantors have been working hard to provide the music for this Mass. I do hope that more families with young children will return and avail themselves of this Mass which is geared toward our younger parishioners.

There is a 2nd collection entitled “Promoting the Gospel” this weekend which supports the Catholic Campaign for Human Development and the Catholic Communication Campaign which assists the impoverished and Catholic media outlets that spread the Gospel message.

This past week I logged on to the link NoTaxpayerAbortion.com to contact our representative in the House of Representatives, our two federal senators, and the President, and to sign a petition electronically to preserve the Hyde Amendment that has been in place for almost half a century and supported by Democrats and Republicans to prevent federal tax dollars from being used to pay for abortions. Currently this Hyde Amendment is under attack, and I urge you, if you have not already done so, please to log on to the link indicated above and express your support of this longstanding Hyde Amendment. Thank you!

This weekend we honor the fathers and father-figures in our lives. All for Jesus, all for Mary, all after thy example, O Patriarch Joseph. Such shall be my motto in life and death.

Prayer for Father's Day

Let us praise those fathers who have striven to balance the demands of work, marriage, and children with an honest awareness of both joy and sacrifice. Let us praise those fathers who, lacking a good model for a father, have worked to become a good father. Pastoral Planning**June 20 ~ Twelfth Sunday of Ordinary Time**

In today's gospel, we see a sleeping Jesus with frightened disciples in stormy waters. A scene that calls to mind those times when we have been afraid, worried, even desperate. Crying out to Jesus, we ask why is he not saving us, protecting us. Just as Jesus reassures the disciples, he does the same for us. The invitation Jesus gives us today is to assess our trust in him. As his disciples, do our lives witness to a trust, and faith that sustains us in good and not so good times? Is there someone in need of Christ's reassurance today? "Don't be afraid" he is with you!

THE WEEKLY UPDATE

Now that summer has finally arrived and school is out we will be planning our regular routine of clean-up and sprucing up we do at this time of year. One of those will be sealing the cracks and re-striping the parking lot. This year that project will be more involved because we have 3 separate catch basins that are in need of repair—two in the front parking lot and one in the rear. On the day that this project is scheduled it will be important that the front parking lot be completely clear of cars, so we'll give as much advanced notice and as many reminders as possible as the date approaches. We're also getting a price to repair some of the sidewalks around the Church. We will also be doing a complete carpet cleaning in the Church and multiple projects in the School. Next week we begin the new fiscal year. The Parish Finance Council at its final meeting for this fiscal year reviewed the budgets for the School and Parish. Since the meeting occurred after this note was written, the final result of the meeting will be in the Operations Note next week. We have received and reviewed the final draft of the Purchase & Sale Agreement for the property being sold to the Town of Milton for the new East Milton Fire Station. We expect it to be signed shortly and for the sale to be finalized in July. Finally it was great to see that we again surpassed our budget target for the Weekly Offertory. In the last two weeks we have reduced the running deficit in the Offertory for the fiscal year by almost 10%! Thanks so much for your generosity.

With Eviction Moratorium Ending June 30, Families Have Options for Help

While the Commonwealth of Massachusetts begins to ease many of the restrictions that have been in place since the start of the pandemic, individuals and families throughout the state are still facing the risk of losing their homes due to financial hardships brought on by the COVID-19 public health emergency. Now due to additional federal funding, there is increased emergency housing assistance available to Massachusetts residents through the Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP).

ERAP, which builds upon the existing Residential Assistance for Families in Transition (RAFT) and Emergency Rental and Mortgage Assistance (ERMA) programs, will provide Metro Housing Boston and their regional partners across the state with more resources to help families with incomes up to 80 percent of the area median. In the Boston region, that is \$90,950 for a family of three.




