

A Note from Our Pastor,

One day this week we'll be having line painting in our parking lot. There will be signage to indicate it, we'll post the date on our website, and it will be announced at the 9am daily Mass at least a day in advance.

Automobile access to the Church property that day will be through the driveway beyond the rectory. We are hopeful that the painters will tackle the parking lot behind the school first while the 9am Mass is going on, and, after Mass concludes, the front parking lot will be painted.

This week is the local summer mission week for our teens who because of post-pandemic travel concerns will be doing service projects locally. Curley Hall at St. Elizabeth's Church the teens from St. Agatha's, St. Elizabeth's, and St. Mary of the Hills parishes are hosting an **Across Generations Dialogue**. The teens would like to meet with retirees, enjoy coffee and doughnuts together, and listen and speak with one another about issues pertinent to the lives of teens and of senior citizens. Read Reflect Respond

THEME: Jesus the Living Bread

As you hear this reading, what words or phrases strike you? How do these words of Jesus touch your heart? What single line remains in your memory?

Gospel : John 6: 41-51

The Jews murmured about Jesus because he said, "I am the bread that came down from heaven," and they said, "Is this not Jesus, the son of Joseph? Do we not know his father and mother? Then how can he say, 'I have come down from heaven'?" Jesus answered and said to them, "Stop murmuring among yourselves. No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draw him, and I will raise him on the last day. It is written in the prophets:

They shall all be taught by God.
Everyone who listens to my Father and learns from him comes to me. Not that anyone has seen the Father except the one who is from God; he has seen the Father. Amen, amen, I say to you, whoever believes has eternal life.

I am the bread of life. Your ancestors ate the manna in the desert, but they died; this is the bread that comes down from heaven so that one may eat it and not die. I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world."

FAITH FORMATION UPDATES



Registration for the 2021–2022 Grades 1–8 Faith Formation Year has closed. If you would like to register for this year's program please email the faith formation office at faithformation@stagathaparish.org.

Preparation for the reception of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion is a two-year process generally in grades 1 and 2. If your child is beyond the first grade and has not participated in a preparation program, please contact the Faith Formation Office to discuss enrollment in the program.

Grades 1–5 will continue to use the home-based “Discover! Finding Faith in Life” program. A child-friendly, self-directed online learning platform. This engaging program supports the domestic church, allowing families the convenience and flexibility to complete faith lessons at their own pace. Along with the home-based program, BELIEVE sessions; in-person family gatherings aimed to foster community and faith sharing will be held on six select Sunday mornings throughout the year. Two session times for the Sunday BELIEVE sessions will be offered, either following the 9:30 am Mass or following the 11:30 am Mass.

Grades 6–8 -EDGE will meet approximately twice a month on Thursday nights in the Gathering Space from 5–6 pm and 6:30–7:30 pm.

The faith formation program is volunteer-based. Please consider volunteering to help, there are several ways you can share your gifts and talents. Below is a list of volunteer opportunities. - **Catechists** are needed to help facilitate faith-sharing activities with small groups of families at the six BELIEVE sessions. All materials/support will be provided.

- **Family ambassadors** are needed to support small groups of faith formation families by checking in with them monthly either through phone or email.


