A Note from Our Pastor,

I hope everyone had a blessed and enjoyable St. Patrick's Day this past Thursday and St. Joseph's Day this weekend. While the priests with whom I live here enjoy corned beef and cabbage, I never acquired a taste for it, but my parents, especially my mother, considered it almost a religious obligation to have it on St. Patrick's Day, given our Irish heritage. My first year of graduate studies in Washington, D.C., I did something I always dreamt of doing on St. Patrick's Day. I got together with another priest from Boston whose parents were of Italian background, and we enjoyed a delicious Italian dinner! I suppose some of you are shaking your heads in disgust at my culinary selection for St. Patrick's Day, but I imagine our Patroness St. Agatha who hailed from Sicily would give me a big "thumb up"!

I might have shared this with you before, but I remember when I arrived for studies in Washington, the Marine Corps Band put on a concert in late August entitled "Christmas in the Summer." They performed a number of Christmas carols which was something new for me in the heat of the summer. I mention it because we have this coming week a glimpse of Christmas in Lent as this coming Friday we celebrate the Solemnity of the Annunciation, when the Archangel Gabriel brought God's message to Mary, inviting her to be the Mother of His Son. Why at this time? Well, the date is March 25th for this Solemnity, and move forward 9 months and the date is—yes, you guessed it—December 25th when we celebrate the birth of Mary's Son Jesus, born after 9 months in His Mother's womb. Given the violence now being perpetrated on the Ukrainian people by Russia, it would be especially appropriate this year to recall one of the secrets revealed when our Lady appeared to the 3 children in Fatima in 1917 in which Mary called all believers to pray for the conversion of Russia. So, I'd encourage us all to ask Mary's intercession for an end to the horrendous violence being inflicted on the people of the Ukraine, and for the conversion of Russia, especially on March 25th, the Solemnity of the Annunciation.

This Sunday I hope there will be a large number of our parishioners coming to hear Mother Olga of the Sacred Heart speak to us on the topic of "Increasing Your Holiness in Lent." The presentation will take place in the Upper Church at 2pm.

Please also note that on Saturday March 26th after the 9am Mass here there will be another Across Generations Event involving teens from St. Agatha's and from the Visitation Collaborative which hosted a similar event last summer at St. Elizabeth's Church to which retirees were invited. Many who were present for that event hoped that another such event would take place later. Well, it's later and St. Agatha Parish is the host this time. In addition to engaging conversation, there will also be coffee and donuts. So teens and retirees are invited to continue the conversation about life and faith and discover what they can learn from one another.

Just a reminder that on Wednesday evenings during Lent from 6:30 to 8pm there is Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in the Chapel, and also the opportunity for the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) in the Reconciliation Room in the Chapel and (if need be) in the Meeting Room in the back of the Gathering Space.

Please also note that next weekend there is another bottle and can drive, as well as a 50-50 raffle to help fund this year's Appalachian Service Trip for our teens which will take place during the April School Vacation Week. There is also a gofundme page, and the opportunity to take part in a 3-on-3 basketball tournament on Saturday April 2nd the proceeds of which will go toward the ASP Mission Trip.

For those planning ahead, our St. Agatha School students will be starring in Disney's Beauty and the Beast, Jr. on Friday April 1st, Saturday April 2nd (both performances at 7pm), and Sunday April 3rd at 2pm. All shows are at Fontbonne Academy and tickets are on sale now at the St. Agatha School Office or at the door before each performance, for the price of just \$10. It promises to be a lot of fun.

Gospel: Luke 13:1-9

Jesus said to them in reply,




