

FEATURED WEEKLY READING

Read Reflect Respond

THEME: Come home. God's forgiveness is always there. God forgives before we even ask for forgiveness.

You have heard this parable many times. When you listened to it today, what word or phrase or image really struck you? What feeling does this story leave you with?

Gospel: Luke 15:1-10

Tax collectors and sinners were all drawing near to listen to Jesus, but the Pharisees and scribes began to complain, saying, "This man welcomes sinners and eats with them." So to them he addressed this parable.
 "What man among you having a hundred sheep and losing one of them would not leave the ninety-nine in the desert and go after the lost one until he finds it? And when he does find it, he sets it on his shoulders with great joy and, upon his arrival home, he calls together his friends and neighbors and says to them, 'Rejoice with me because I have found my lost sheep.' I tell you, in just the same way there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous people who have no need of repentance.

"Or what woman having ten coins and losing one would not light a lamp and sweep the house, searching carefully until she finds it? And when she does find it, she calls together her friends and neighbors and says to them, 'Rejoice with me because I have found the coin that I lost.' In just the same way, I tell you, there will be rejoicing among the angels of God over one sinner who repents."

Pastoral Planning

September 11 ~ Twenty-fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

St. Paul, in his letter to Timothy, acknowledges his weakness and sinfulness but does not allow it to stand in the way of God's grace and his desire to serve as a minister to God's people. His reliance on God's grace and mercy is what motivates him to minister in the name of Christ. In our gospel, Jesus makes it clear that God does not want to see anyone lost, because of sin. In fact, as hard as it is for us to believe, when we acknowledge our sinfulness and try again to be faithful, God celebrates our return. Is there something that stands in the way of your reliance on God? Name it and confess it to God so that the celebration can begin!

St. Agatha Parish is excited to host a live workshop for parents and their daughters (suggested ages 9-12) called **Cycle Prep**. Guest speaker Christina Valenzuela explains the science of the menstrual cycle in an understandable and engaging way that enables parents and their daughters to be prepared to navigate the natural changes to a girl’s body which come with menstrual cycles.

The workshop will take place on Wednesday evening, September 28 from 6:30 to 8:00 pm in the Gathering Space. The workshop is intended for parents and their daughters (suggested ages 9-12) or for parents to attend without their daughter. This is not a drop-off event.

Boys and girls of all ages are invited to register for St. Agatha Parish Basketball. Sign ups for the **In-House league** will be done solely online on the parish website. **Registration for the league will start on September 13th**. Registration will close when the maximum number of players has been reached. The link will be available on the parish home page (www.stagathaparish.org).

The basketball program is open to all parishioners as well as students of St Agatha School. The program is divided into age groups ranging from Pee-Wee (Grades K-2) and going all the way through the 8th grade. The In-House program runs all day on Saturday and on Sunday afternoon. The fee is \$90 per child with a maximum of \$180 per family. The fee will include a new tee-shirt. The Pee-Wee season starts on October 22nd with all other age groups starting on October 29th.

The **Travel League** registration will also be done online this year. **Registration for the league will start on September 13th and end November 1st**. The registration fee for the Travel League will be \$200 per player. New uniforms are not included in the registration fee but you may purchase one when you register for \$50 per uniform.

Our goal is to teach basketball skills in a fun and safe environment while learning to compete with good sportsmanship. The program has been extremely popular in the past, and the capacity at some grade levels has been reached quickly. It will be important to sign up as early as you can to ensure availability, as late registrations will only be accepted on a space available basis.

We are also in need of volunteers to help coordinate the program and coach our many in-house and travel teams. The program has served nearly 500 youngsters in past years, but we are only able to do this with the help of many great people that are willing to share their time to help form our youth. If you are a parent of a child that is signing up for the program, there will be an option to select on the online registration form if you are interested in coaching/volunteering. A member of our Sports Advisory Board will then be contacting you in the near future. There will be a CORI/training meeting on September 20th from 6-8pm in the Gym for all volunteers.
