As you hear this reading, what words or phrases strike you? What in this reading touches your heart? What lingers in your memory?

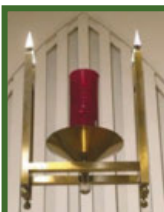
Gospel: Luke 10:1–9

At that time the Lord appointed seventy-two others whom he sent ahead of him in pairs to every town and place he intended to visit. He said to them, “The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest. Go on your way; behold, I am sending you like lambs among wolves. Carry no money bag, no sack, no sandals; and greet no one along the way. Into whatever house you enter, first say, ‘Peace to this household.’ If a peaceful person lives there, your peace will rest on him; but if not, it will return to you. Stay in the same house and eat and drink what is offered to you, for the laborer deserves his payment. Do not move about from one house to another. Whatever town you enter and they welcome you, eat what is set before you, cure the sick in it and say to them, ‘The kingdom of God is at hand for you.’”

July 6 ~ Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

“The harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few; ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest.” By virtue of our baptism, *we* are the ones being sent out as “laborers for his harvest.” Imagine the difference it will make if we begin His work right within our own parish! Can you help by being a lector or an extraordinary minister of the Eucharist? Can you help by volunteering with hospitality, with set-up or clean-up after Mass or around the property? Being a “laborer in the Kingdom” starts to happen when we see our church, our parish as our home. What response will we give to Jesus’ invitation, “Go on your way...I am sending you...”? OPERATIONS UPDATE

Happy Summer!

As July quickly approaches, all continues to go well at St. Agatha Parish. We’ve been busy with several improvement projects in both the Rectory and the Church.

As previously shared, the lighting in the Upper Church has been upgraded. We’ve installed brighter, soft white lights that are both energy-efficient and visually pleasing, enhancing the beauty of the church’s interior while providing greater comfort for your eyes. Additional lighting updates will take place over the coming month.

Last year, I wrote an article in the Parish Bulletin about an opportunity to support St. Agatha through **Charitable Giving via your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD)**. By donating your RMD through a qualified charitable distribution, your gift—if made before year-end—may be excluded from your taxable income. You can choose to donate your entire RMD or any portion of it.

We are grateful to two generous families who made such a contribution, designating their gifts specifically for improvements to the Rectory, with a focus on the priests’ living spaces. Since the beginning of June, we’ve been making substantial progress: painting has begun, floors are being repaired and refinished, new blinds have been installed, beds and bedding have been replaced, and the common areas are being refreshed. While work is still ongoing, the space is being transformed into a more modern and comfortable home for our beloved priests.

We extend heartfelt thanks to these families for making this important work possible in support of the dedicated priests at St. Agatha Parish.

The Confirmation Program at Saint Agatha Parish

The Cardinal changed the age of Confirmation to 8th grade for all parishes starting in Fall of 2024 and the Archdiocese gave parishes 3 years to implement these changes. St. Agatha Parish made the decision for grades 8, 9 and 10 to have the ability to receive their Confirmation for the 2025–2026 Confirmation season. This change prepares 8th graders to make their Confirmation in spring of 2026. Confirmation preparation is still a 2-year program but instead of taking place in grades 9 and 10 it begins earlier, in grades 7 and 8 respectively.

For those students that may be older and looking to reconnect with Faith Formation for their Confirmation, they are funneled to the 8th grade class. The schedule is still being finalized but grade 8 will meet on Thursdays from 6:45 PM to 8 PM every other week (twice a month) starting in late September/early October and we go into the April/May time frame.
