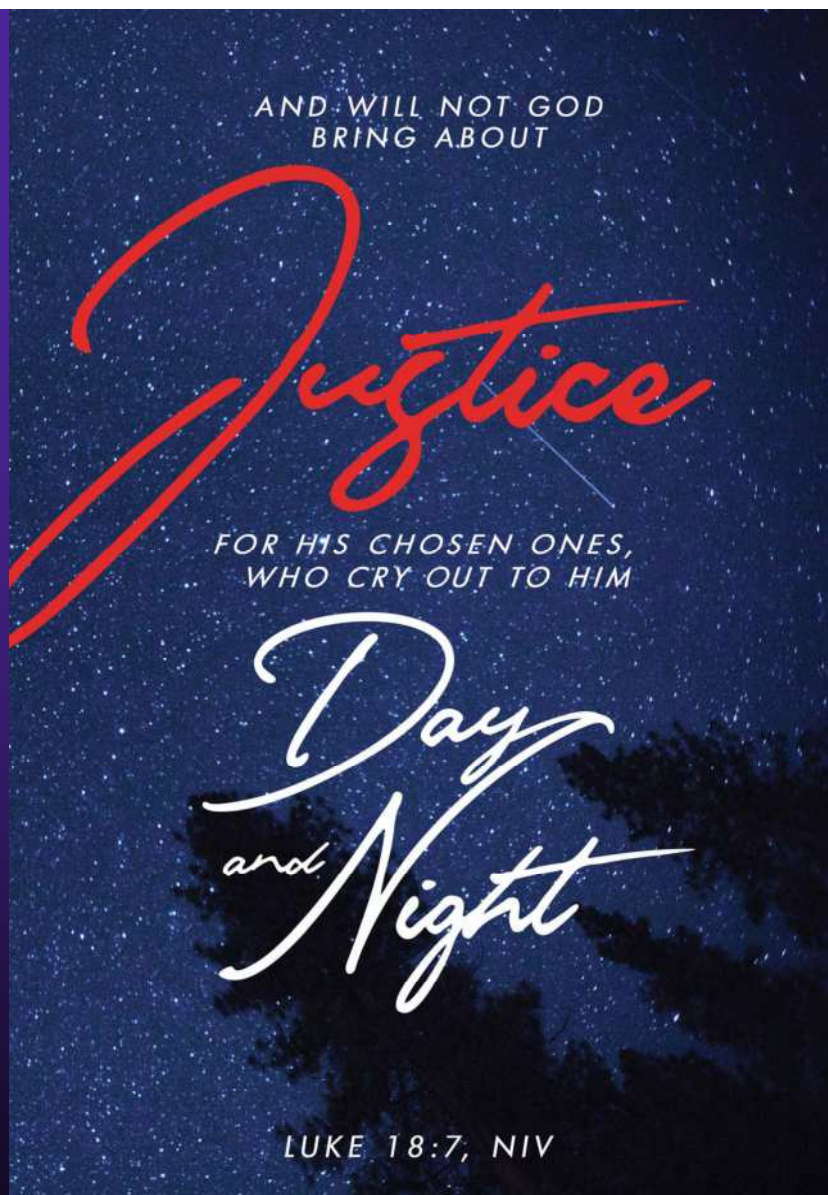

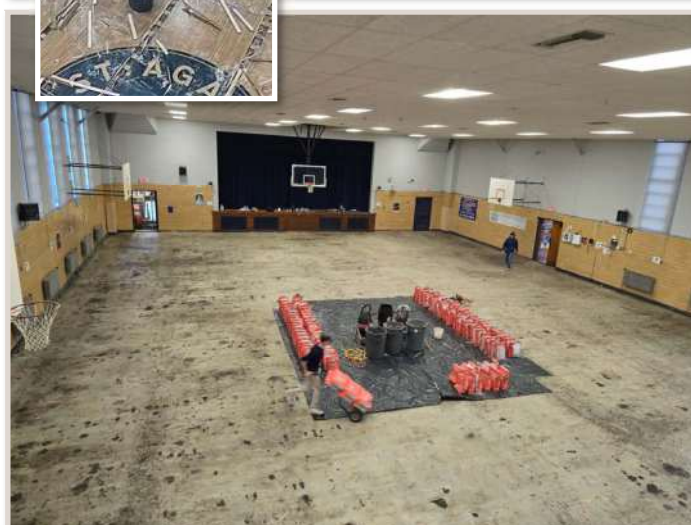
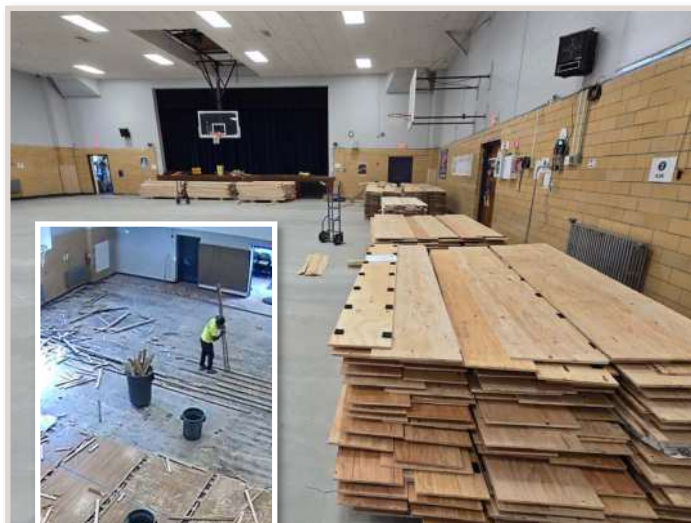
OPERATIONS UPDATE

We're excited to share that the gym construction project is well underway! Last week, the existing gym floor—covering all 6,000 square feet—along with the subflooring, was removed down to the concrete slab. Remediation work on the concrete was necessary to ensure a smooth and level surface for the new flooring base, and that work was completed this past Tuesday.

The new flooring materials, shipped from Wisconsin, have arrived and been carried into the Parish Center. Installation is already in progress, marking an important milestone in the project. Over the next two weeks, we will complete the first phase of the Parish Center transition.

We're thrilled about this transformation and the renewed space it will provide for our school and community programs. I look forward to announcing the date for the Parish Center ribbon-cutting ceremony soon.

Thank you to everyone for your continued support of this important project for St. Agatha Parish.

THEME: Never stop praying. Have faith and never give up!

When you hear the story of this stubborn widow, what strikes you about her? What phrase or word in this reading remains with you now?

Gospel: Luke 18:1–8

Jesus told his disciples a parable about the necessity for them to pray always without becoming weary.

He said, "There was a judge in a certain town who neither feared God nor respected any human being. And a widow in that town used to come to him and say, 'Render a just decision for me against my adversary.'

For a long time the judge was unwilling, but eventually he thought,

'While it is true that I neither fear God nor respect any human being,

because this widow keeps bothering me I shall deliver a just decision for her lest she finally come and strike me.'"

The Lord said, "Pay attention to what the dishonest judge says.

Will not God then secure the rights of his chosen ones who call out to him day and night?

Will he be slow to answer them?

I tell you, he will see to it that justice is done for them speedily.

But when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on earth?"

O.C.I.A. In a comfortable, conversational setting, weekly discussion and presentations aim to help participants draw closer to God, learn about Scripture, prayer, and the life and teachings of the Catholic faith.

OCIA is for someone who: a) was never baptized, or b) was baptized in another faith and now wants to learn about/become part of, the Catholic Church, or c) was baptized Catholic but never received the sacraments of Confirmation or Eucharist (First Communion).

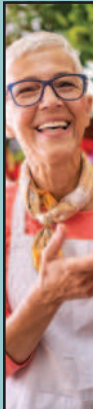
