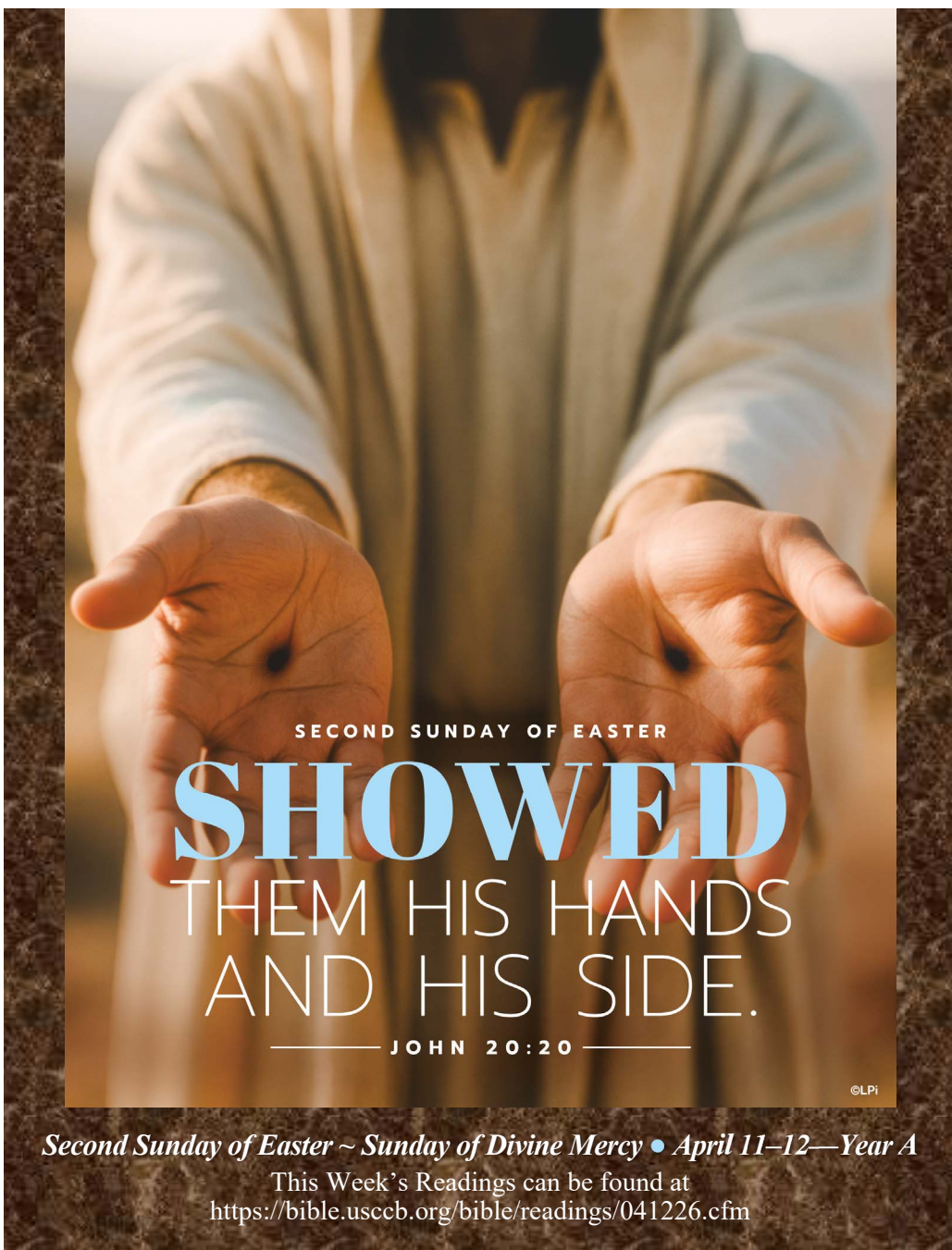

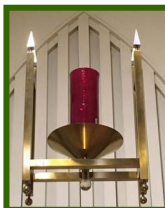

## Pastoral Planning

### April 12 ~ Second Sunday of Easter ~ Sunday of Divine Mercy

This Sunday, our scriptures give us clear instruction about how we are to live as disciples. In the reading from Acts, the author describes the disciples' way of life: "They devoted themselves to the teaching of the apostles and to the communal life, to the breaking of bread and to the prayers." Teaching, prayer and Eucharist, sound familiar? Nourished by prayer and our reception of Holy Communion may we be strengthened to bring the peace and mercy of Christ to others. Today, simply prayer, "Jesus, I trust in you" and listen as Jesus replies "I trust YOU!"

We are looking to put together a team of teens and adults from the parish and the school to go and serve this summer in Cumberland, Maryland through Catholic Heart Work Camp. Trip is July 5 to 11 and is open to all students presently in grades 7 to 12. CHWC is an AMAZING experience of “faith, service and fun”. Home base for the week will be Bishop Walsh School which is a Pre-K-12 Catholic School in the Appalachian Mountains of Western Maryland. Most of Cumberland’s industry departed in the 1980’s leaving many proud, working-class people without jobs. We will be serving elderly and poor residents with home repair, as well as churches, service organizations and nursing homes. All skills are needed but THE MOST important skill is to have an open heart to God and others. The cost for the trip is \$700 (which includes housing, food, transportation, t-shirt). 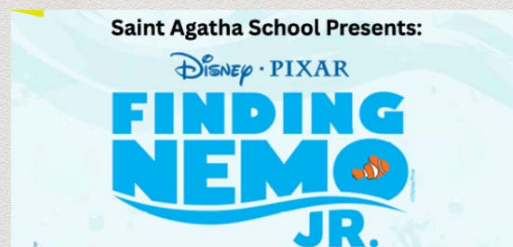


