> We know that all things are possible with you, and through this campaign, we strive to revere you. We ask that you give us full hearts so that we may reach all who should hear your voice.


We ask this through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God forever and ever. AMEN.






