The Slice of the Pie Fundraiser had a successful year and Al Cormier reported that participation for this coming year will be approximately the same as last.

Projects:

Fr. Marc + Al Cormier updated the committee on the status of various projects. Now completed are Air Conditioning in St. Jos. church and expansion of the food pantry area of St. Jos.

Rectory renovations are basically finished as well.

New Stations of the Cross for MQP have arrived and need to be mounted.

Starting Oct. 4 the painting inside at St. Jos. will begin, followed by new flooring.

We are getting quotes for re-pointing of masonry stone at St. Jos. We have a quote for removing the oil tank at St. Julie Hall. After discussion, the general feeling was that we should proceed with this.

The dishwasher at St. Julie Hall recently failed, and has been replaced.

The signs in front of both churches have been updated to reflect the new Mass times.

On the back burner for now are: power washing the brick at MQP and some possible tree trimming at St. Jos.
