Sacred Relics of The Saints: Treasures of The Church

**Exposition of Sacred Relics Of 150 Saints
St. Mary's Catholic Church, Fosston, MN**

Fr. Carlos Martins, CC, will present at St. Mary's Parish, 725 6th St. NW, Fosston, MN, a teaching and exposition of Sacred Relics on **Friday June 1 at 6:30 pm**. Father Carlos Martins of the Companions of the Cross with his special ministry will teach about these holy objects. He will bring with him over 150 relics, some as old as 2000 years. Among the treasures will be relics of St. Maria Goretti, St. Therese of Lisieux (the "Little Flower"), St. Francis of Assisi, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Thomas Aquinas, and St. Faustina Kowalska. In addition, there will also be present a portion of the veil of Our Lady, as well as one of the largest remaining pieces of the True Cross in the world. Those in attendance will be able to examine and venerate each relic. In the Church's history many miracles and healings have been worked in the presence of relics, and many have been healed through this ministry. You are encouraged to bring your articles of devotion (such as rosaries, holy cards, etc.) and pictures of ill friends/family members which you will be able to touch to the reliquaries as a means of intercession. The veneration of relics is a communion with the heroes of our Christian faith, asking for their powerful intercession. Memorial Day Cemetery Decorations

Many put out special decorations on the graves of their loved ones over the Memorial Day time. New rules for the **Roseau and Falun** cemeteries ask that these decorations not be put out before one week (May 20) before and that they should be removed by June 7. This will enable caretakers to mow and maintain the cemeteries properly. Decorations that are attached to headstones or in vases attached to the headstone base, etc. can remain longer as long as they look decent. When decorations become unsightly, deteriorated or dangerous will be removed by caretakers. As for the **Badger** cemetery, still working on the rules, we will follow the rules above as at Roseau and Falun.

Capital Campaign Update

A quarterly report will again be sent out in June to all parishioners in regard to their pledges. Along with this there will be an update on the financing and pledging needed to cover the loan that will be required to cover the second half or less of the building project. A lot will depend on the bids that we receive on the project and when the contractor can begin the project.

Otherwise, in general we are in a very good position with the funds and pledges that have been coming in. We have raised **\$681,904.00** which is a little more than the half cash needed to do the base project (est.: \$1,350,000). Our goal now is to reach at least \$725,000 in cash on hand which will be half of the full project (est.: \$1,540,000) w/o the paving of the parking lot.. -- Fr. John and Capital Campaign
