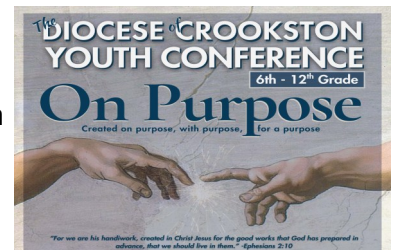
World Mission Sunday is October 19
